- 1. - 2. This scholarship is open to all students attending Public and Private High Schools in Okaloosa County.

- 6. Completed applications include the RCOC application as a first page with the essay and every question answered fully. (It is acceptable, but not required, to send this page as a separate file from the essay and question responses.) Incomplete applications will automatically be disqualified. Proper grammar, spelling, vocabulary and writing skills will factor into the scoring of your application.
- 7. The RCOC scholarship committee will review all fully completed applications after the deadline and determine finalists, for in-person interviews. Please provide a reliable contact phone no. on the application.
- 8. The selected finalists will be notified on or before Monday, April 22, 2024. Projected in-person interviews will be held after class hours either Tuesday April 23rd or Wednesday April 24th, 2024. NOTE: If you are taking an AP exam at home either of those days, we will accommodate that testing schedule. If you are participating in an approved school function, we will also accommodate that schedule.
