Continuity of Services/Ready for Learning Plan (Including COVID Policies)

COVID and/or COVID Symptoms	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> • If a student or staff member is sent home with COVID symptoms, the individual must have two negative antigen (at-home) tests 48 hours apart to return to school. • Students and staff need to contact the nurse if they test positive. (This is for data purposes and the eligible return date). • After a positive test result, students and staff will be eligible to return to school on day 6 if fever free for 48 hours and symptoms have improved.
Closure Due to Inclement Weather, Contagious Disease, or Other Emergency Circumstances (Acts of God, Utility Outage)	Fordyce Schools will opt to utilize the make-up days in the approved school calendar if possible. The remaining make-up days will be added to the end of the school calendar.
Physical Distancing	Cafeteria seating at the elementary level facilitates faces one direction, one seat between each student. All breakfast is served in classrooms, reducing exposure to multiple sets of students. Pre-K- 6 is served beginning at 7:30 am, and 7-12 is served between first and second periods each day.
Hand Washing/ Cleaning	<p>Hand sanitizer is provided in each building at entrances as well as in each classroom. Soap, paper towels, and posters with reminders about washing hands are prominently placed throughout the buildings.</p> <p>All buildings are cleaned throughout the day.</p>
Ventilation/Air Circulation	Air purifiers are placed in every classroom and non-classroom space in all district buildings.
Visits to Schools	Visitors to buildings log into the Visitor Management System upon arrival. The system takes a photograph of the visitor and tracks entry and exit times.
