WHAT IS EARLY COLLEGE?

The Early College classes at Enoch's allows students to take transferrable MJC courses during their school day - receiving both high school AND college credit at the same time!

WHO SHOULD TAKE AN EARLY COLLEGE COURSE?

Any Student who can manage college level courses and plans to apply to a 2 year or 4 year college after graduating from high school may benefit. Student course grades will post to their permanent college transcript so it's important that students are prepared.

WHAT ARE THE BENEFITS OF EARLY COLLEGE?

Early College classes are considered honors level courses and are calculated on a 5.0 GPA scale, similar to AP, but Early College courses award instant college credit with no additional test required. Students earn credit for one college semester course + credit on their high school transcript.

CAN I TAKE EXTRA MJC CLASSES IN ADDITION TO EARLY COLLEGE CLASSES?

Yes! Students may choose to take additional courses through MJC outside of the regular school day as dual enrollment courses free of charge.

IS EARLY COLLEGE THE SAME AS AP?

No. Students who are enrolled in AP courses must pass a test and apply for potential college credits to count at a college. Successful completion of an Early College course is transferable to 4 year colleges and universities.
