Speech and Language Pathologist

Responsibilities:

- Speech and Language Pathologist responsible for developing and monitoring speech and language IEP goals, providing therapy, collaborating with other clinicians, special education and general education teachers, and other school staff.
- Maintains Teacher of Record responsibilities
- Provides a thorough assessment and diagnosis of speech, voice, rhythm, and language impairments; provides hearing screenings and additional assessments (formal and informal) to inform goals and services.
- Provides a therapeutic program to meet the individual needs of students with speech and/or language impairments.
- Serves as a resource to school staff members in the development of a balanced program for improvement in articulation, expressive and receptive language, and phonemic awareness.
- Assists in proper referrals and maintains lists of referred, screened, and eligible students, as well as a directory of outside agencies, consultants, specialists, and related services.

- Assumes primary responsibility for requisitioning and maintaining needed equipment and supplies.
- Tracks referrals and placements by age, grade level, and disability area for Continuous Progress Monitoring.
