Frequently Asked Questions

Do I need to attend all day?

No, you can attend any or all parts of our celebration. Please let Mrs. Neumann know what parts you are interested in attending for planning purposes.

Do I need to bring anything?

You do not need to bring anything. However, students love when Veterans bring in photos, mementos, uniforms or other "show and tell" items.

How will Veterans know where to go?

Veterans can enter the school building at Door 1 (the district doors) or Door 25 (the highschool entrance) Once in the building student leaders will escort Veterans to breakfast and to classrooms.

- Can Veterans spend the whole day with their students?

 Each classroom has its own schedule and activities planned for Veterans Day. Typically, it does not work for a Veteran to spend all day with a student.
- What ages will Veterans be speaking to?
 Small groups of Veterans visit three classrooms.
 The students can range in age from kindergarten to eighth grade.

What background knowledge will students have?
All students should be familiar with what a Veteran is and have prepared questions to ask if there is time.
