



The New Rider Course/Basic Rider Course (NRC/ BRC) is aimed at beginning or re-entry riders. The course consists of:

- A 5-Hour on-line training program that MUST be completed before your scheduled class weekend of hands on training
- A combination of guided instructionand practical riding exercises in a controlled, off-street
- environment
- An on-bike skills test and written exam.

Motorcycles are provided for you to use during the class and helmets are also available on a first-come/ first served, free loan basis, if needed. Becasue loaner helmets are limited. we strongly suggest you bring your own undamaged (no previous accidents or crashes) D.O.T. approved 3/4 OR full faced helmet.

Upon successful completion of the course you will recieve a course completion card which will assist you in obtaining a motorcycle endorsement on your license. Course completion may also qualify you for reduced insurance premiums on your motorcycle insurance. Please check with your individual insurance provider for details.

NOTE: You must attend all sessions and pass the exam and skills test to recieve the completion certification card. The Missouri Department of Revenue will waive both the written test and the riding skills portion of the motorcycle endorsement process when you presesnt your completion card at the DMV.

## Registration for **Short-Term Courses**

Fall registration begins the first week of June for on-line customers each year. Students may register on-line, in person or by mail. Course fees are due at the time of registration.
