COMMUNITY AND DISTRICT

The Somerville School District is ideally located in central New Jersey, just 60 minutes from New York City, 90 minutes from Philadelphia, and 30 minutes north of Princeton. The district includes Somerville Borough, with a population of approximately 12,000 residents. A number of Fortune 500 corporations and other major businesses have facilities within or surrounding the Somerville community. Traditionally, the community is committed to quality education.

Our Pre-K-12 system includes one elementary school (K-5), one middle school (6-8), and one high school (9-12), serving approximately 2,500 students. The neighboring community of Branchburg sends its high school students to Somerville High School. The school district is noted for its comprehensive curriculum offerings, enrichment programs, and competitive athletic programs.

CURRICULUM OFFERINGS

Somerville High School operates on a two day A/B schedule rotation where students attend eight 76 minute instructional blocks, spread across the 180 day school year. The high school offers state-of-the-art programs in the arts and sciences with more than 130 course offerings. In partnership with Raritan Valley Community College, some students have the opportunity to earn college credits in various disciplines and a cohort of students in each graduating class earns an Associate's Degree through the Somerville Liberal Arts Academy (SALA). Somerville High School has also established a medical science academy (SMSA) in partnership with Robert Wood Johnson University Hospital Somerset. The high school is fully accredited by the New Jersey Department of Education.

WEIGHTED GRADES

Honors and Advanced Placement courses are given an additional weight of 5 points to be calculated in the marking period grade point average and the end of year grade point average.

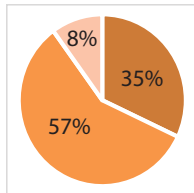

Senior Class Enrollment 281

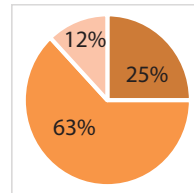

Senior Class Enrollment 275

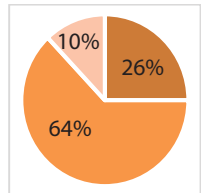

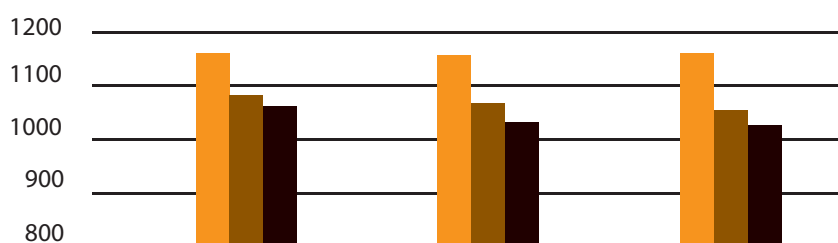

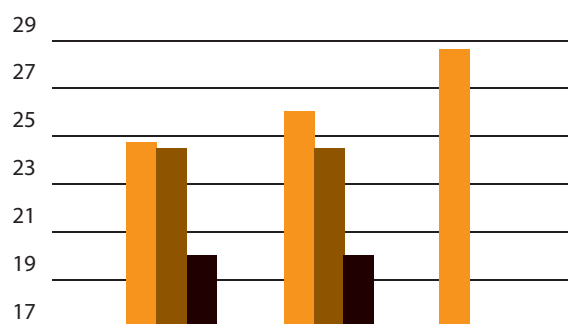
