- Friday: Walking taco (beef or chicken), black beans, lettuce / tomato, corn, sour cream, brownie

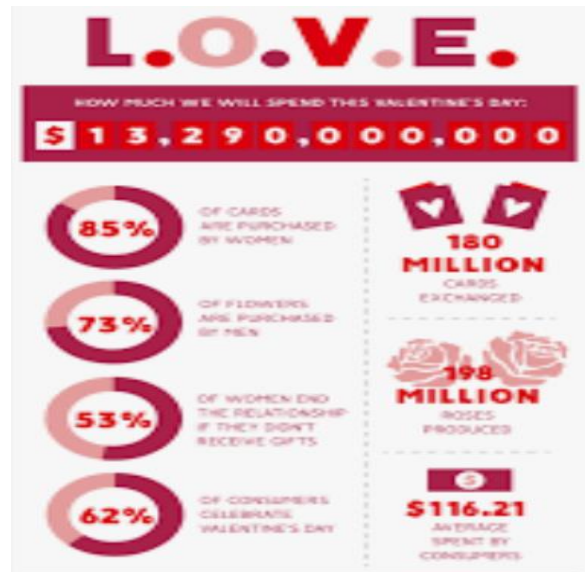
