#### A Reminder from the Nurse



Dear Parents and Guardians,

Please note that if your child is sent home from school due to a fever or vomiting, they will not be able to return until they are fever and vomit free for 24 hours.

#### Staying home from school when your child is sick:

**Fever:** Keep your child home for a fever of 100.4 or greater. A child with the flu will be excluded for a fever of 100 degrees with cough and/or sore throat until they are fever free for at least 24 hours without any fever reducing medications.

<u>Vomit.</u> Keep children at home when vomiting has occured 2 or more times in a 24 hour period. Children cannot return to school until they are vomit free for at least 24 hours.
