Cherokee County School District administers the Cognitive Abilities Test (CogAT) and the Iowa Assessments to all second and fourth grade students each fall as part of the South Carolina Gifted and Talented Assessment Program and the district-wide identification process for Gifted & Talented services. The testing window for these assessments is October 9th – 13th. Your child's specific testing dates and times are determined by each building and listed below. **Please make every effort to have your child attend school during the testing weeks, paying specific attention to the exact testing date(s) for your child's class.**

South Carolina mandates the administration of these assessments. These assessments must also be administered by a trained Test Administrator on the school campus.

Secondary Screening

Based upon the results from this testing, a secondary screening using a performance assessment will be provided for possible candidates in February or March. You will be notified if a secondary screening is necessary.

Student Preparation

No special preparation is required for the CogAT/Iowa Assessments. However, you can encourage your child to answer all the items and give their best effort. We also recommend your child have a good night's sleep and a healthy breakfast on testing days.
