Guidelines for Painting

1. Positive & Appropriate Content
 - All messages and images must be positive, school-appropriate, and family-friendly.
 - No profanity, political statements, advertisements, or anything that could be considered offensive or divisive. CCSD Code of Conduct rules apply.
2. Painting Materials
 - Only latex or spray paint may be used - painting party responsible for all materials.
 - No adhesives, glitter, or other permanent materials.
3. Clean Up
 - Painter is responsible for removing any trash, paint cans, or supplies after painting.
 - Surrounding areas (sidewalk, grass, etc.) must be protected and left clean.
4. Painting Window
 - Painting may begin on Monday of the reserved week and be complete by Tuesday of the same week.
 - Only the group listed on this contract may paint during their reserved time.
5. Liability
 - Painters are responsible for any damages to school property caused by painting.
 - The school is not responsible for accidents, injuries, or damage to personal property.
6. School's Right to Remove
 - The school administration reserves the right to paint over or remove any message that violates these guidelines.
