- · Be mindful about your social media user names. Make sure they are work appropriate.

- · Don't follow your students on social media...Period.
- Don't have a public account. Be cautious about your privacy setting on your account.
- Never drink and tweet or post, and be mindful about the type of post you share online.
- Don't set up or update your personal social media accounts using the District's computers, network, or devices.
- Don't use the District's logo or other copyrighted material of the District on your personal accounts.
- Don't post during work hours.
- · Think twice before connecting with parents on social media.
- Don't post students on your page.
- Don't tag Lancaster ISD with religious posts.
- Don't reply to media inquiries.
- If you so happen to get a request, please direct them to the Lancaster ISD communications department.
