Don't forget that Storybook Character Dress Up Day is taking place on Tuesday, October 31st. All students and staff are encouraged to dress up as a storybook character. Please be reminded that all outfits must be school appropriate. No scary Halloween costumes, no full face masks, and no pretend weapons of any kind may be worn as part of a storybook character outfit.

This Tuesday, October 31st is also an Early Dismissal Day with school dismissing 2 hours early at 12:30 pm. All bus riders will arrive home 2 hours earlier than their normal drop off time. Our car rider line will begin at 12:30 pm and all car riders should be picked up no later than 1:00 pm on Tuesday.
