Overview of Title I

- Title I is the United States federal government's largest education assistance program for schools.
- The purpose is to help every child receive a high quality education and to achieve the high standards set by the state of North Carolina.
- To be recognized as a Title I school, the student population must have 40% or more identified as needing free and reduced lunch.





Title I at Estes Elementary School

- Title 1 funds are used to provide Estes with a Curriculum Coach, two Reading Intervention Specialists, and four Title 1 instructional assistants.
- Our model is small group differentiated intervention for 30 minutes each day.
- We progress monitor students regularly.

- There are three categories for Title 1 funds: Discretionary, Professional Development, and Parental Involvement.
