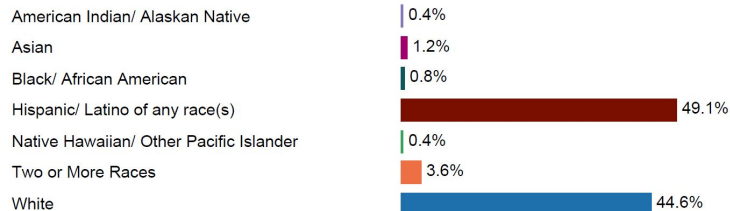

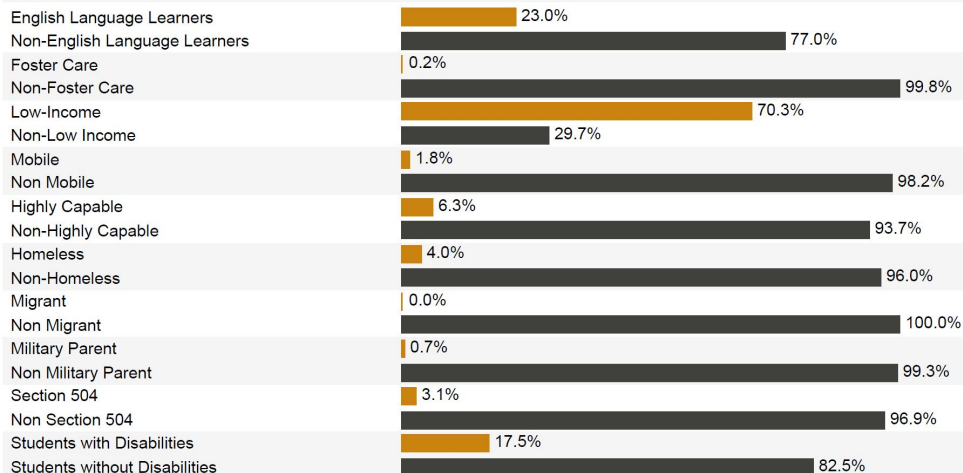

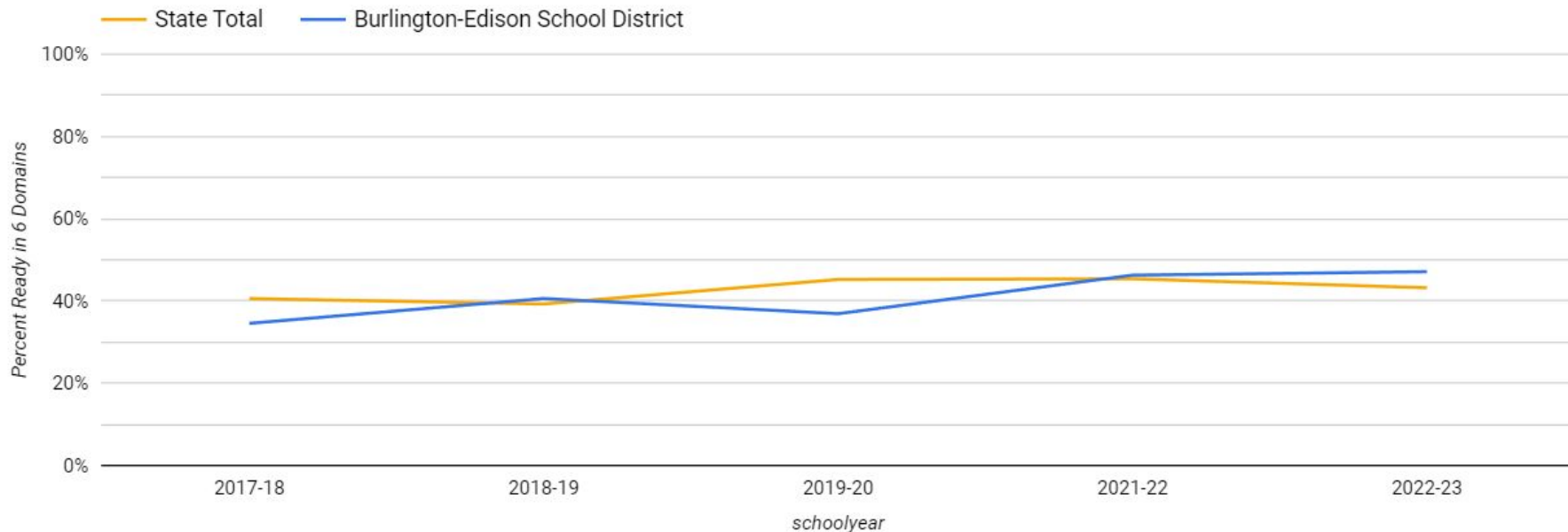

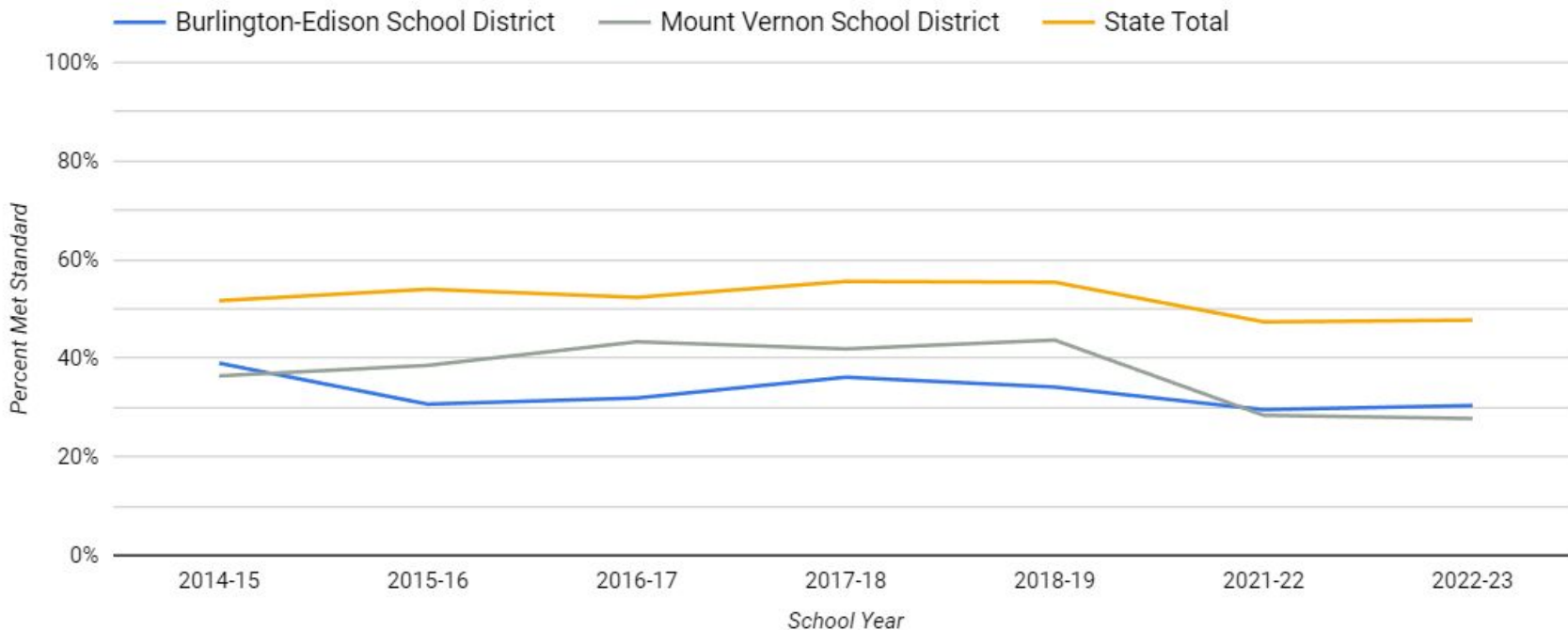

Percent of students entering kindergarten ready in all six areas of development and learning



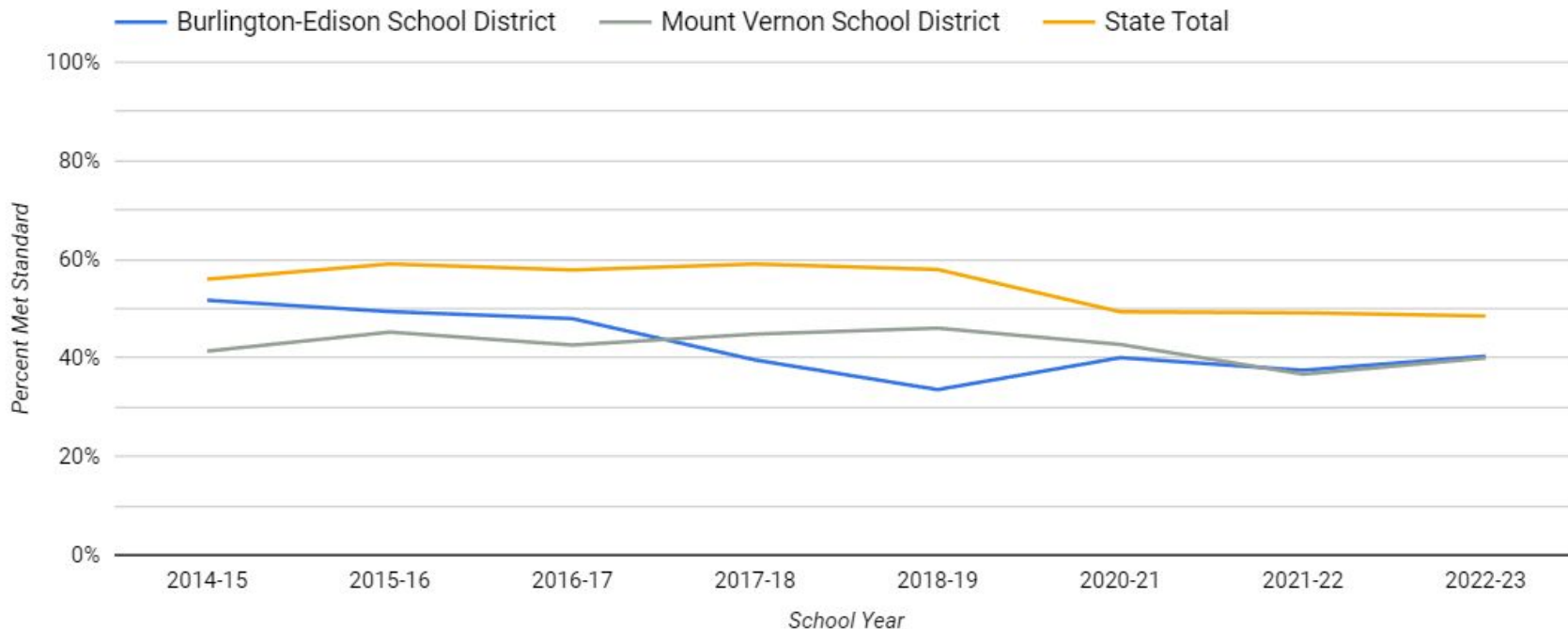

SBA ELA Assessment for Grade 3 by Year - B-ESD/Mount Vernon vs State Averages



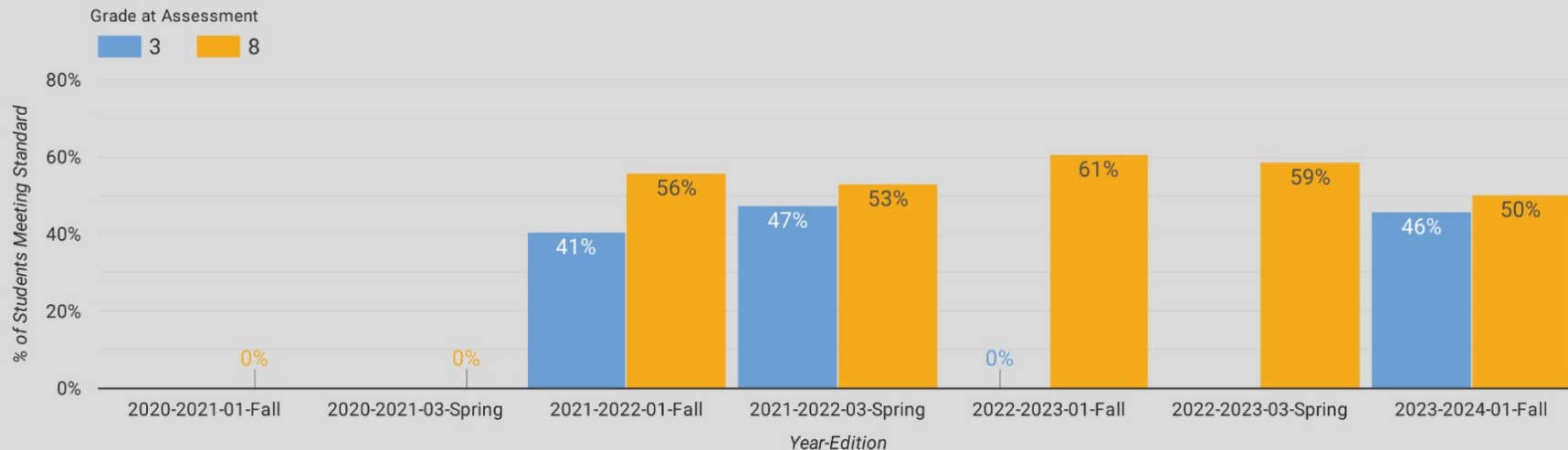

SBA ELA Assessment for Grade 8 by Year - B-ESD/Mount Vernon vs State Averages



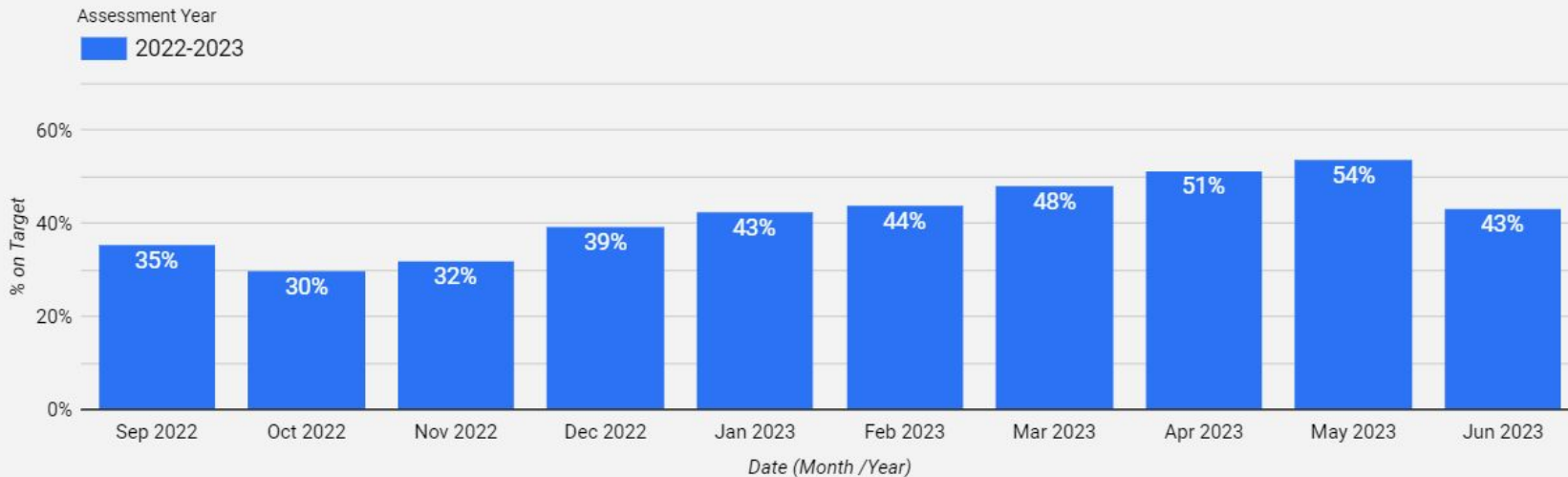

MAP ELA Percent Meeting Standard by Year



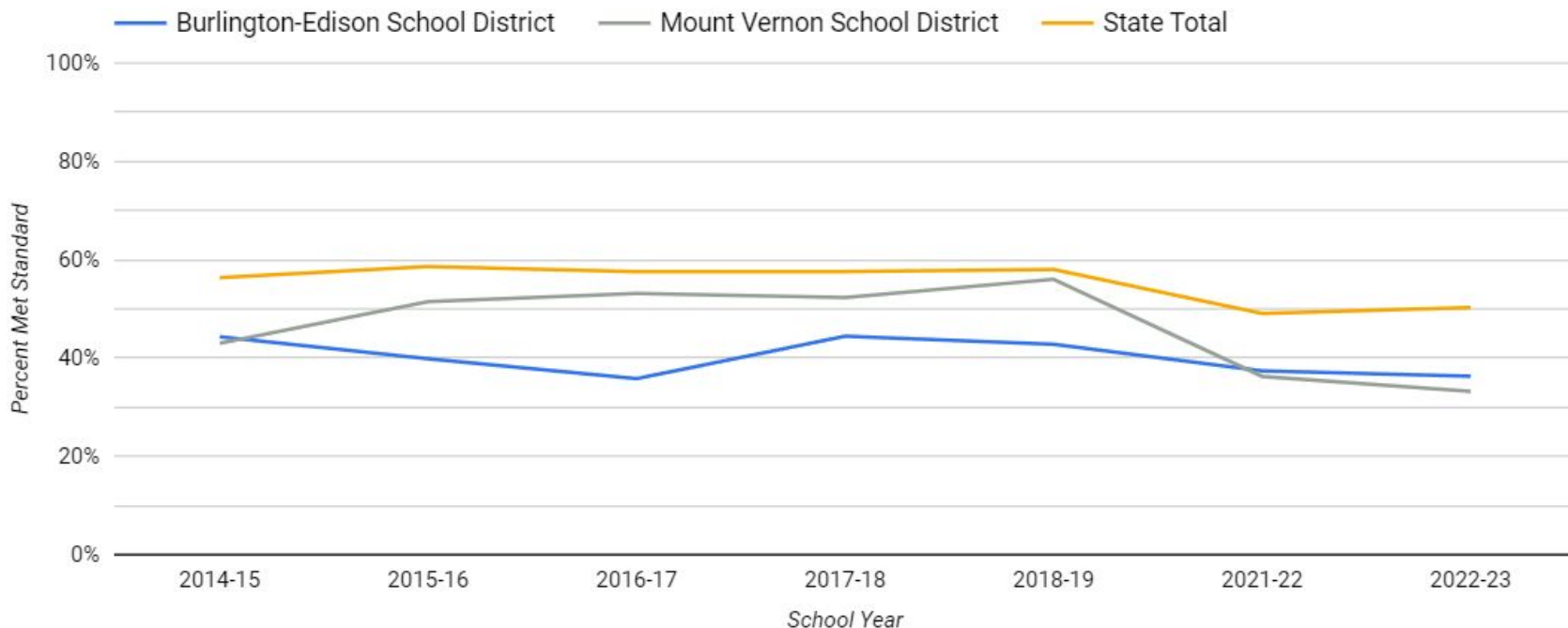

ARC Schoolpace IRLA % Students on Target by Year



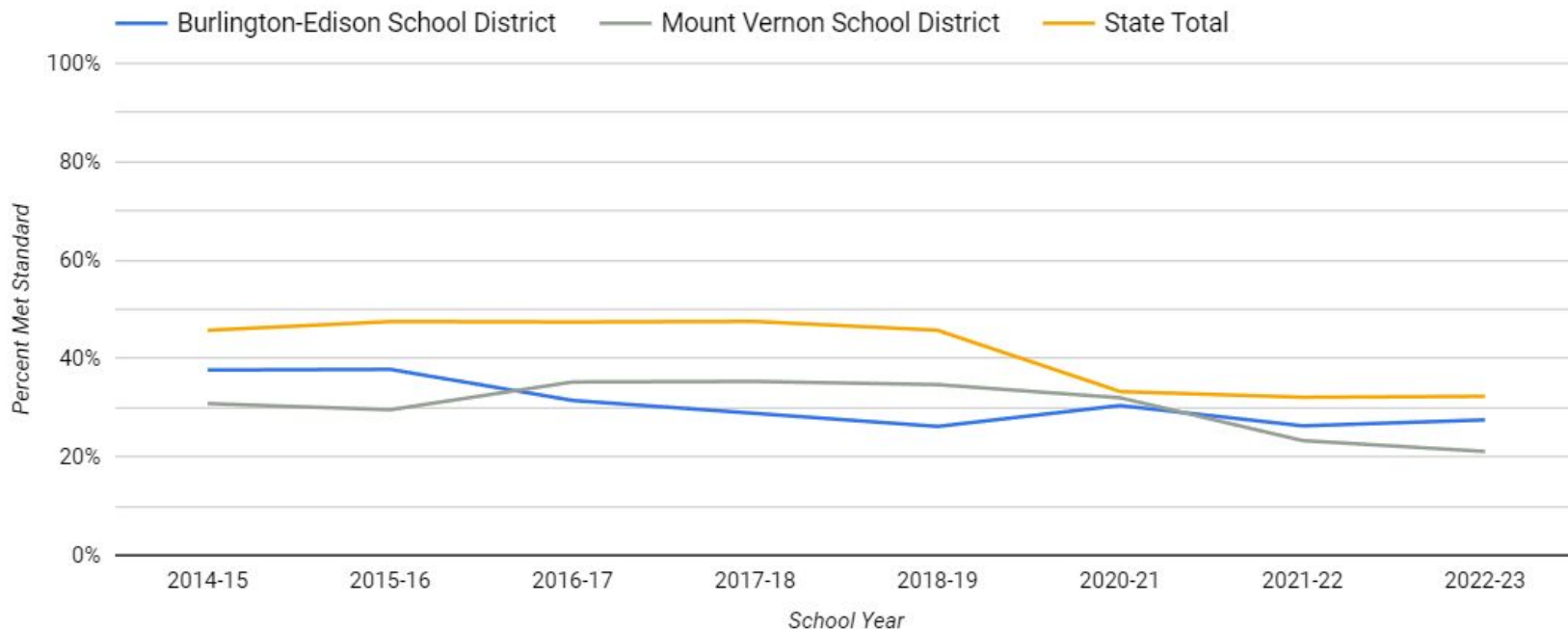

SBA Math Assessment for Grade 3 by Year - B-ESD/Mount Vernon vs State Averages



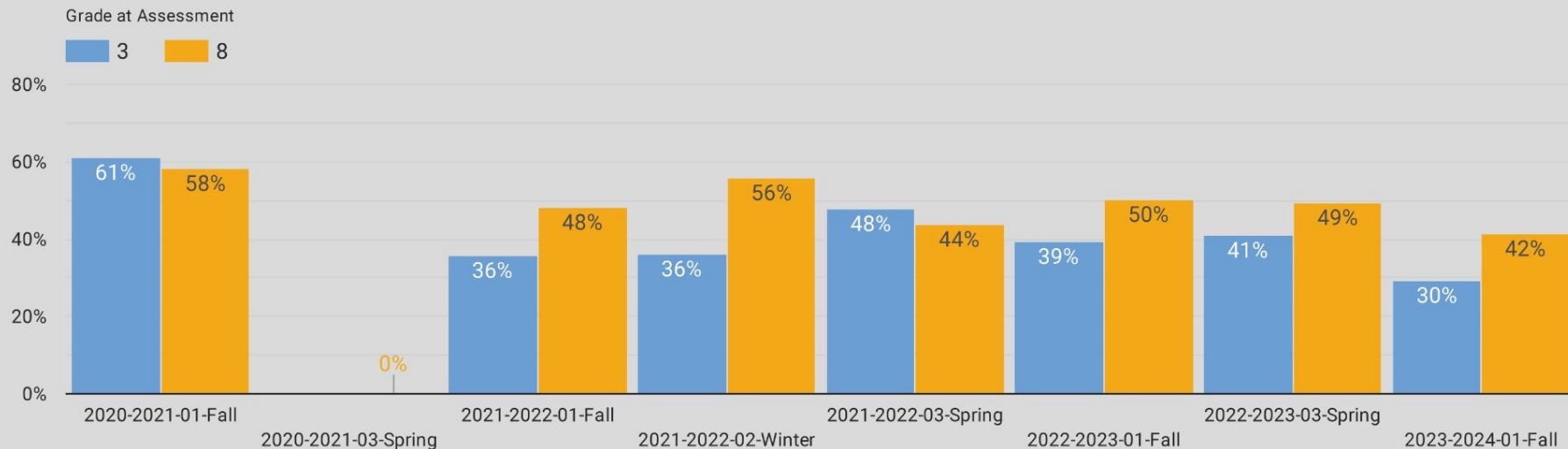

SBA Math Assessment for Grade 8 by Year - B-ESD/Mount Vernon vs State Averages

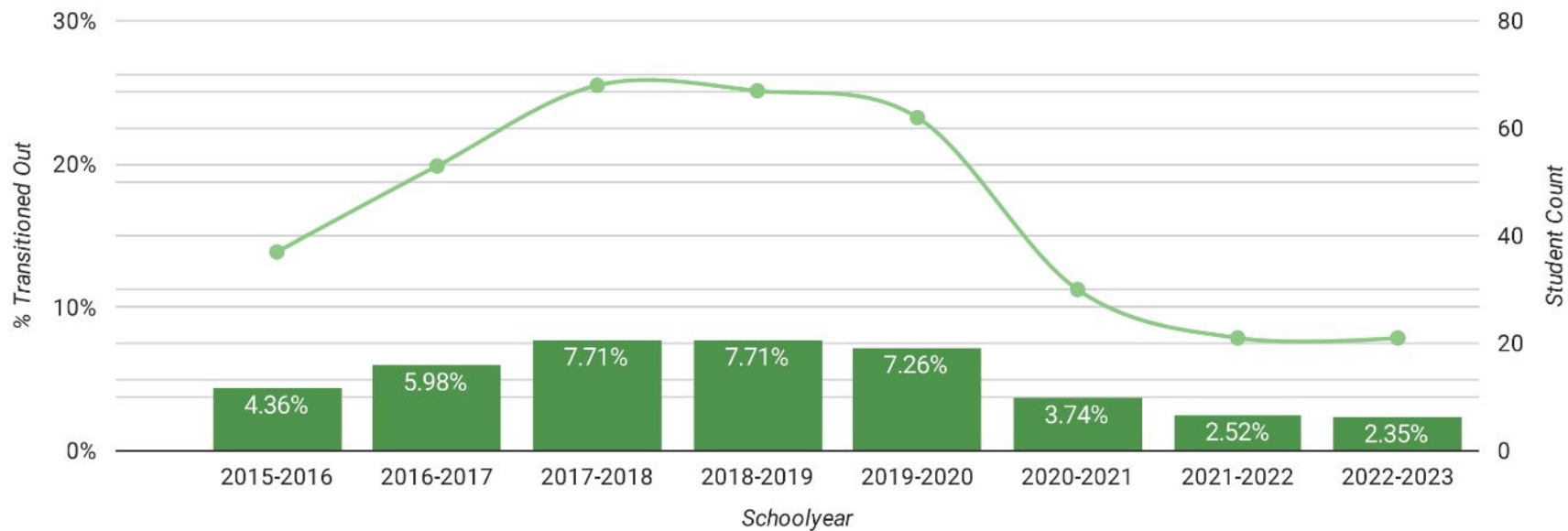

Percent of ML Students exiting from Services Annually

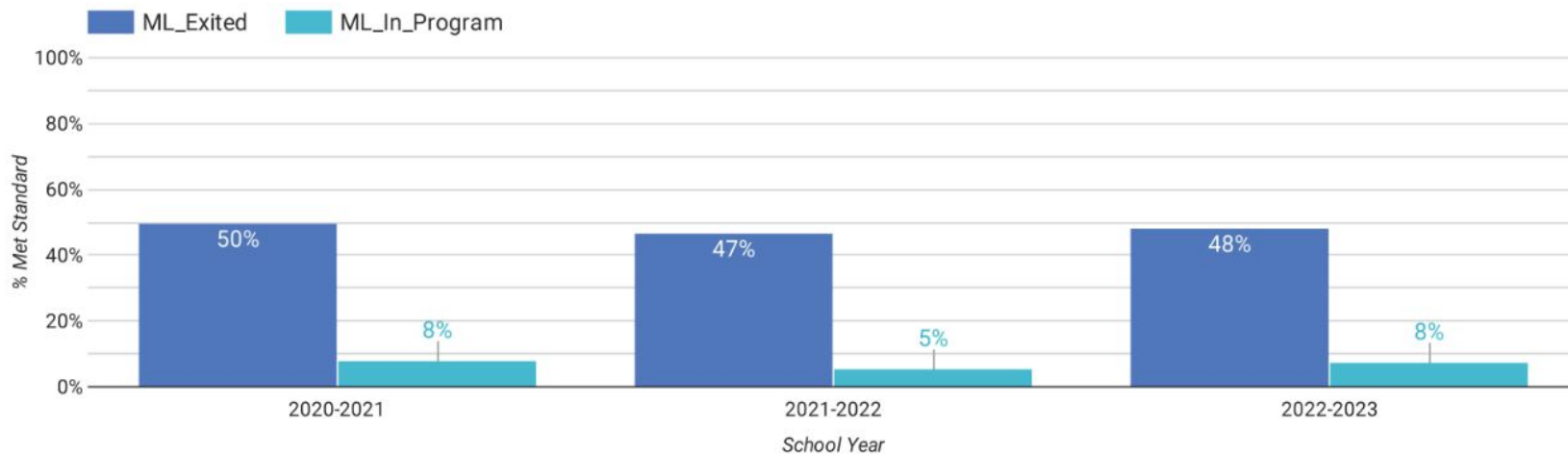


Smooth Line shows the Total Student Count Transitioned for each year

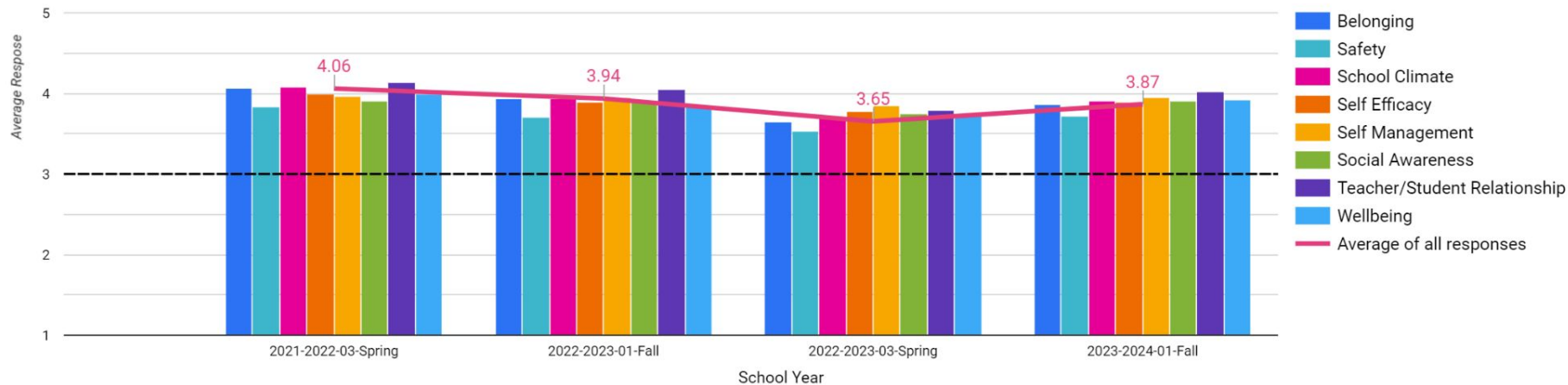
Percent of ML Students Meeting Standard in SBA - ELA for Exited and In Program by Year

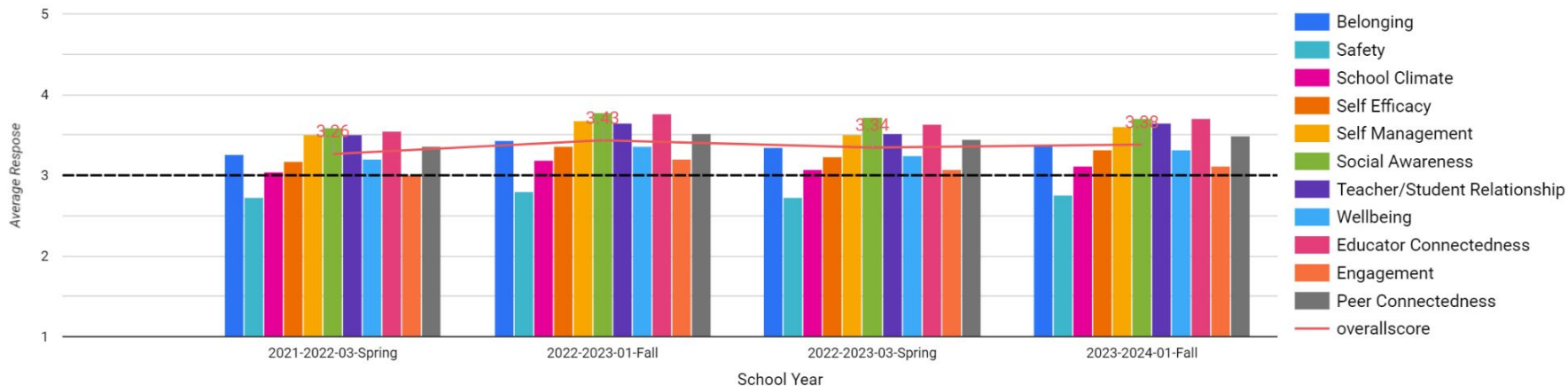
Average responses by school year

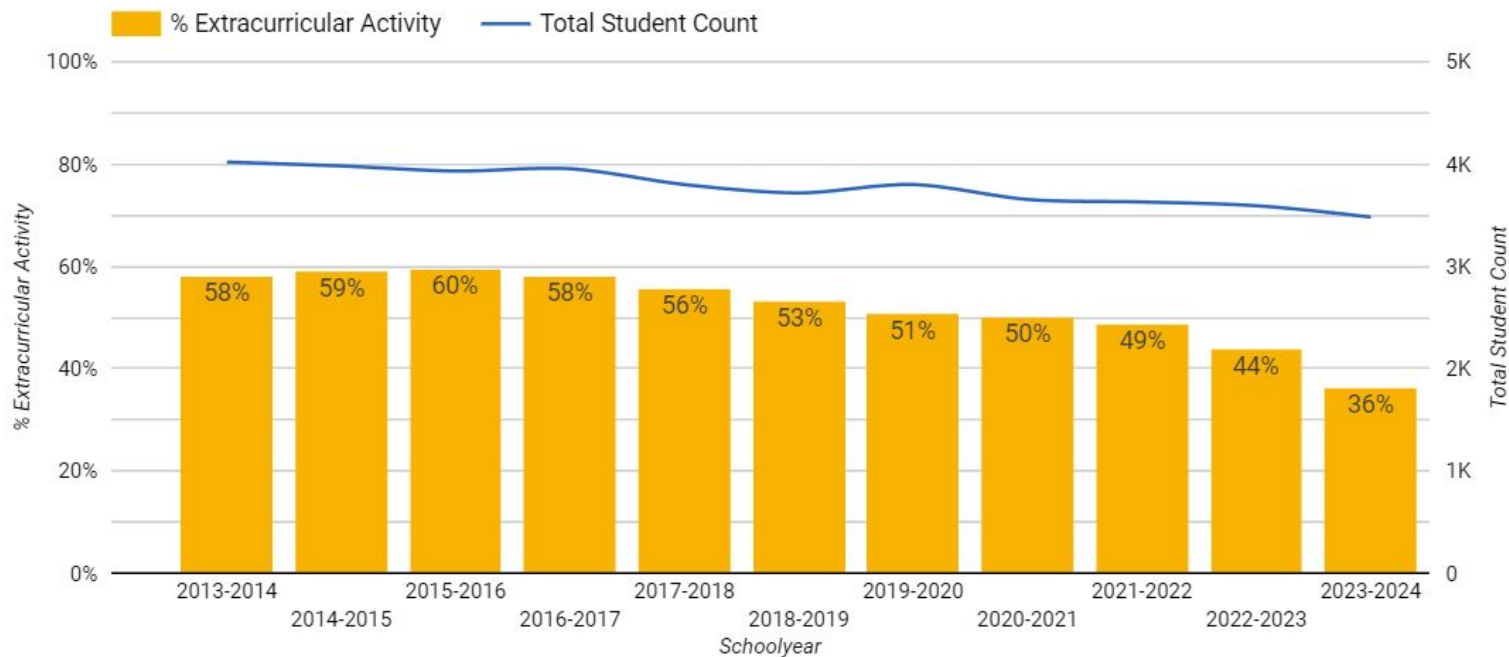

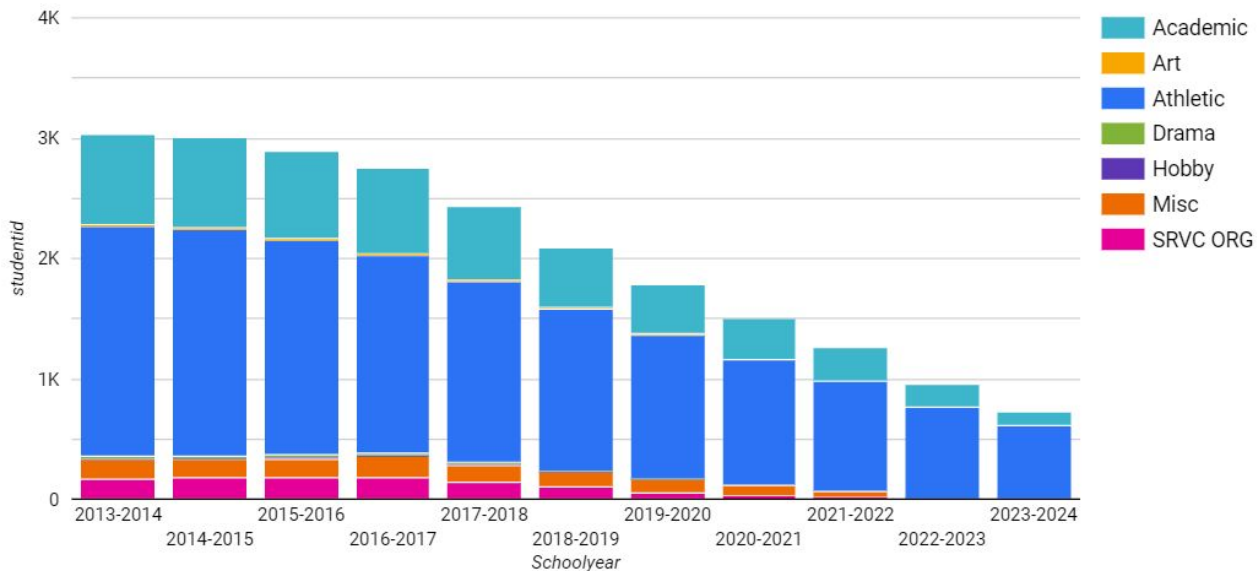
Percent of students participating in an Extra Curricular Activity by Year

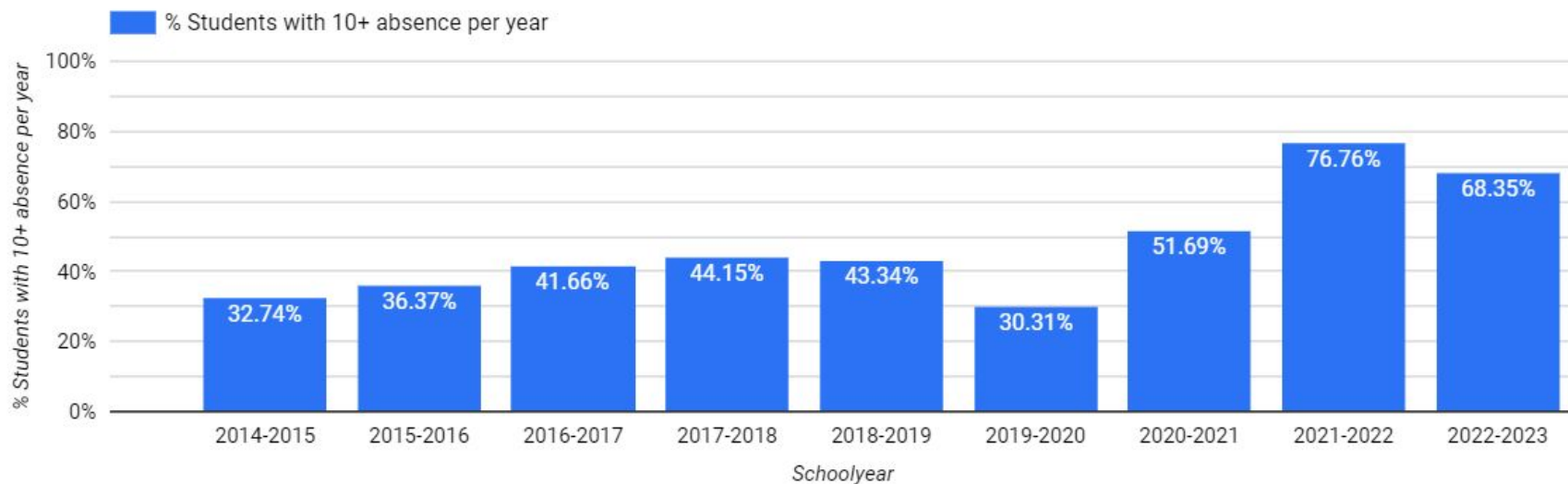
Count of students participating in an Extra Curricular Activity by Year and Activity Type

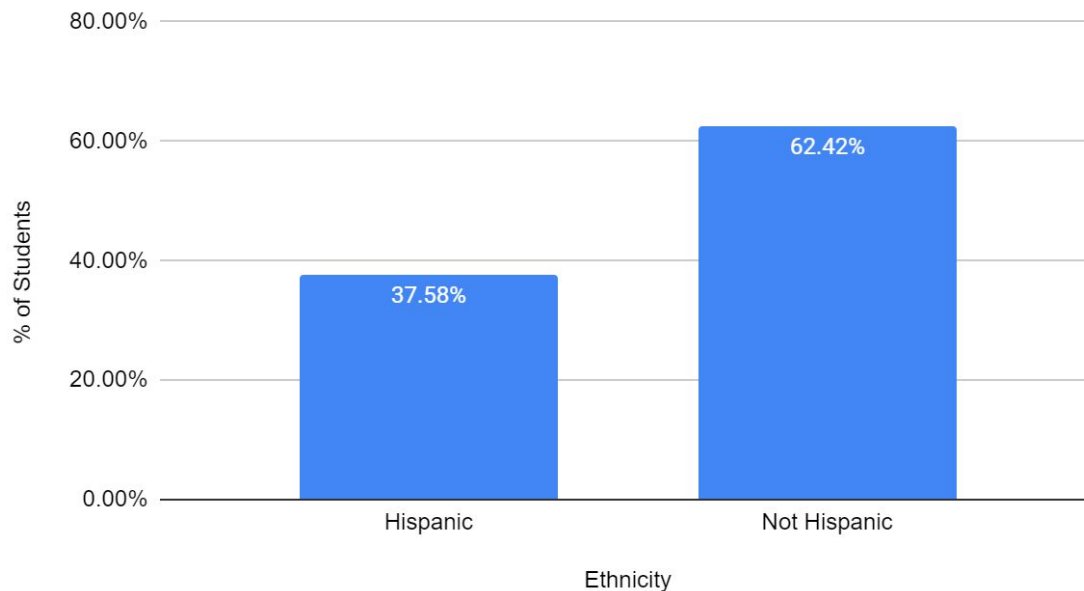
Chronic Absence Report

Percent of Students with 10 or more Absences per year



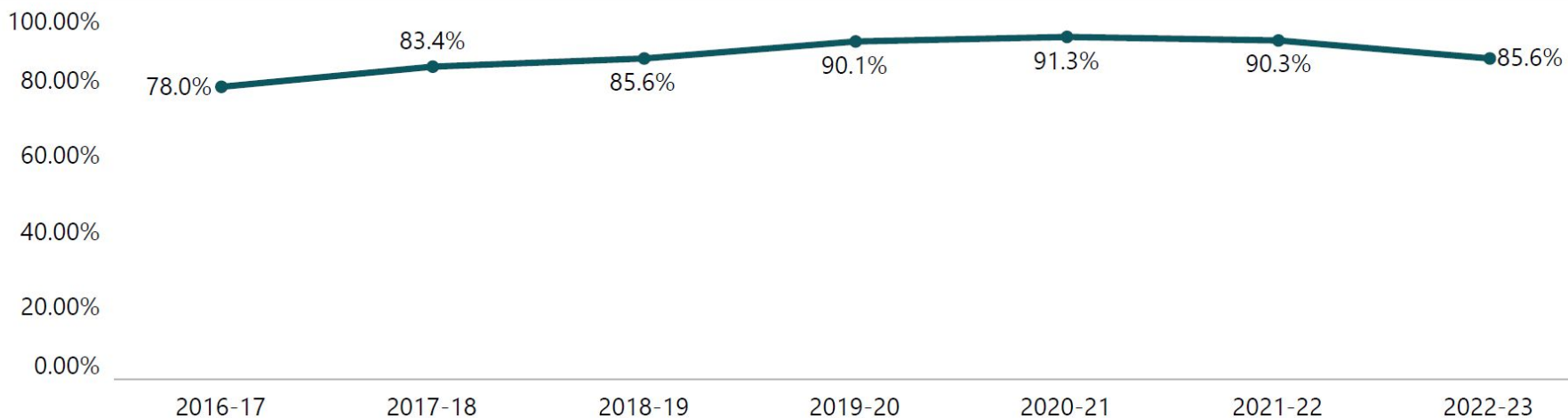

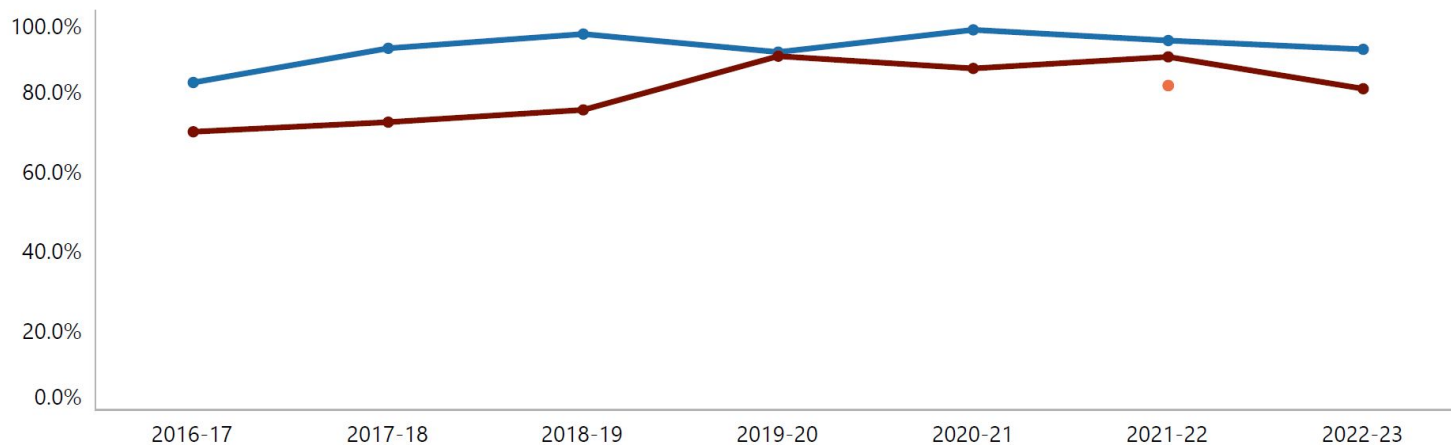

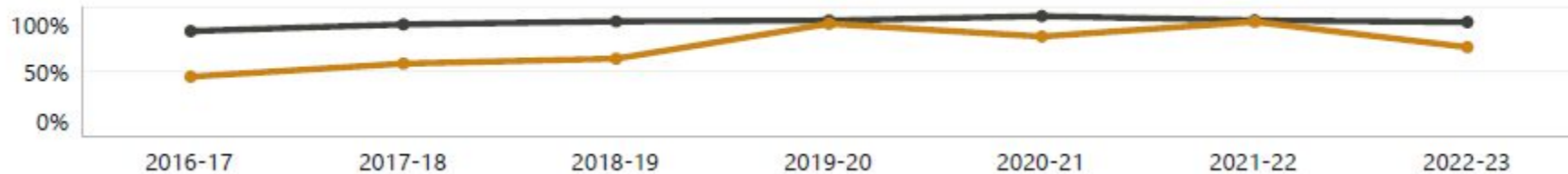

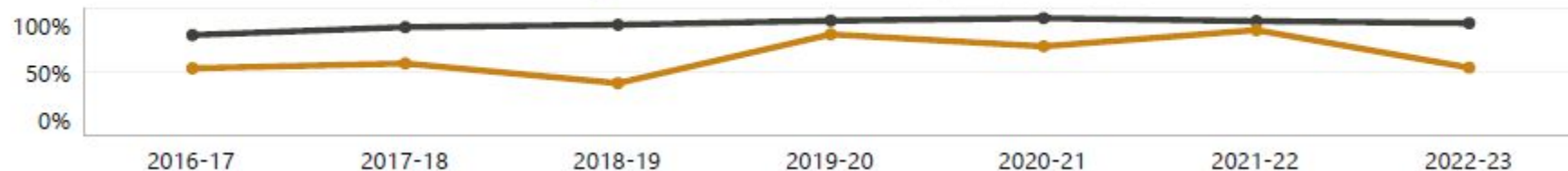

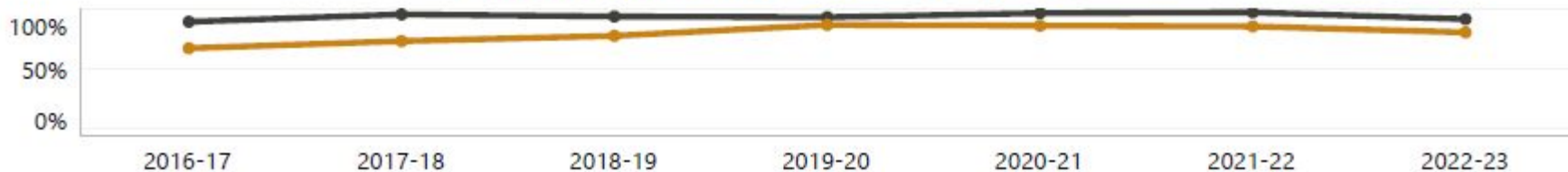

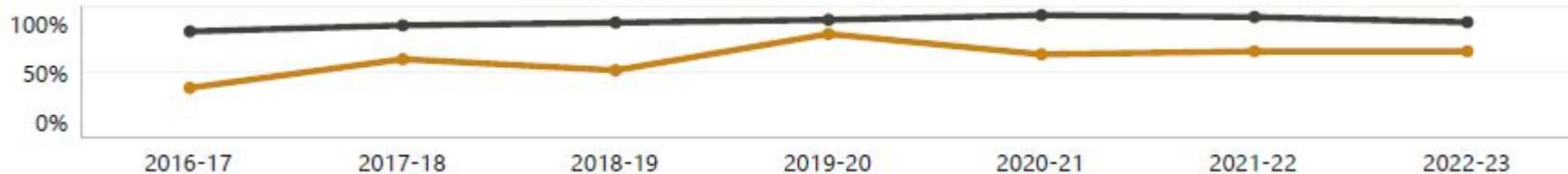


Graduation Rate: Percent of students graduated in four years By Program
