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## Example Junior High Schedule



- Choosing between on-level and advanced classes is a decision between you and your student.
- There is not a criteria on advanced classes.
- You can choose any combination of on-level and advanced classes.
- Content
- English, Science and Social Studies: on-level and advanced classes are taught from the same core curriculum.
- Math: advanced covers $11 / 2$ years of curriculum - all of 7 th grade and $1 / 2$ of 8th grade in one year. This class is accelerated.
