Be It Resolved, the Kearny Board of Education approves all travel not in compliance with N.J.A.C. 6A:23A Subchapter 7 as being necessary and

unavoidable as noted on the approved Kearny Board of Education Out of District Travel and Reimbursement Forms; and

Be It Further Resolved, the Kearny Board of Education includes in the tentative budget travel and related expense reimbursements in accordance with N.J.A.C. 6A:23A Subchapter 7, to a maximum expenditure of \$25,000. for all staff and board members for the 2024–2025 school year.

The School Business Administrator/Board Secretary shall track and record these costs to ensure that the maximum amount is not exceeded.
