








23-24 Attendance Incentive

All Students: Friday, December 15th




- -Earn a C or higher in ALL! classes

- -No skipped evening detentions and no suspensions (ISI or OSS)





Excessive Absences

When excessive absences occur (nine in a year), a medical release that includes the reason for the absence, diagnosis, and date(s) of the absence(s) will be required after any and all illness/medical-related absence(s) in order for the absence(s) to be considered excused.




Social Consequences

→ Students who have accumulated 5 unexcused absences and/or excessive tardies and skips will be placed on social probation.



- Will not be allowed to attend:
 - Extracurricular activities
 - Dances
 - Athletic events
 - School functions
- → Social privileges will be reinstated after 30 days if a positive pattern of attendance has been established.



Absences can add up quickly which can lead to students:

- 1. Falling behind in their assignments
- 2. Lower grades
- 3. Being referred to truancy
- 4. Being placed on social probation (new to this school year)


FLYING THE P STAFF EDITION

Freshman fire, in this challenging space.






