 Illinois Science Assessment (ISA)-Same students at SAT.





→ Students who have accumulated 5 unexcused absences and/or excessive tardies and skips will be placed on social probation.




- Will not be allowed to attend:

- → Social privileges will be reinstated after 30 days if a positive pattern of attendance has been established.

Excessive Absences

When excessive absences occur (nine in a year), a medical release that includes the reason for the absence, diagnosis, and date(s) of the absence(s) will be required after any and all illness/medical-related absence(s) in order for the absence(s) to be considered excused.

Ignites the crowd, acclaiming their fame.


Crafting routines that are appealing to the eye


