- Superintendent Orr called on Mr. Carver, principal for Muhlenberg County High School, to showcase his school. Mr. Carver spoke of the implementation and success of Reading Plus with the Freshman class. Reading Plus is a way for students to increase their reading grade levels. Mr. Carver mentioned that so far in the current school year that they have had 170 students to increase a grade level in reading. Mr. Carver spoke of their credit recovery program to enable their students to earn credits needed to graduate. CTE Pathways were also mentioned and how the Freshman class was able to explore different areas to help determine what career pathway they would like to follow. Lastly, Mr. Carver touched on areas including success in the new cafeteria, improvement with attendance, and how there had been no altercations for the first nine weeks of the school year, and the boys' soccer team being district champs.
