#### PETITION FOR EARLY ADMISSION TO KINDERGARTEN

I am requesting early admission to kindergarten in the Muhlenberg County School System, pursuant KRS 158.030.

I understand the following:
My child will be screened using the Kentucky Kindergarten Readiness Screener, the <i>Brigance Screen III</i> . Those screen results will be used to determine early placement into kindergarten. If it is determined that early placement is an option, the screen results will be used to plan my child's academic program. The results will be shared with me along with the kindergarten teacher's interpretation of what the screening data means in regard to my child's anticipated kindergarten success. As part of the <i>Brigance Screen III</i> , I will be required to complete a self-help/social-emotional inventory and reading readiness inventory as part of this screening. I will also be asked to fill out a parent questionnaire. The prior settings provider will be asked to fill out a skills checklist and submit it to the Muhlenberg County Schools district office. The screening will be administered to my child by mid to late July. The Elementary Supervisor of Instruction will contact me to set up a screening appointment.
If early placement is an option, my child will be provided the same rigorous kindergarten program and supports as all other students attending kindergarten in the Muhlenberg County School System. This includes curriculum content and instruction, assessment, daily schedule and behavioral expectations.
If early placement is an option, my child's progress and performance will be measured using the state standards as a guide, with attention to those standards specific to kindergarten.
If early placement is an option, my child will not be promoted and/or retained as part of his/her public school experience because of his chronological age/birthdate.
If there are concerns in the areas of my child's academic, self-help, and/or social and emotional progress within the first 30 days of school, a meeting will be scheduled with the principal, guidance counselor, my child's teacher and me to discuss these concerns. I may rescind my request of early entry to kindergarten and withdraw my child from kindergarten by providing the school principal with a written request.

# PARENT QUESTIONAIRE (Continued)

3. How does your child respond when he/she tries something that is new and challenging? How does your child respond when not successful?
4. How long does your child maintain interest in an activity of <i>their</i> choosing? How long does your child maintain interest in an activity of <i>your</i> choosing?
5. Describe your child's interaction with books at home.
6. What kinds of experiences has your child had with writing tools such as crayons, pencils and markers? With scissors?
7. What could your child show or tell me about Letters? Numbers? Shapes? Patterns?
8. How does your child respond to change?
9. On a scale of 1-10, how would you rate your child's ability to do things for himself/herself? Why did you choose that rating?
10. Describe your child as your child works/plays with other children.

Your child will be evaluated by qualified school personnel. Upon completion of all assessments, all data collected will be reviewed.

There are two possible outcomes of the individual screening process:

1. The student <u>did not</u> demonstrate the needed readiness skills and <u>is not</u> eligible for early entrance into kindergarten,

OR

2. The student <u>did</u> demonstrate the needed readiness skills and <u>is eligible</u> for early entrance into kindergarten. Families of students found eligible must complete the regular registration process through their school to enroll the student into a kindergarten program for the upcoming year.

# Muhlenberg County Schools Kindergarten Early Entrance Expectation

Kentucky's school readiness definition, "Ready to Grow...Ready to Learn...Ready to Succeed," means that each child enters school ready to engage in and benefit from early learning experiences that best promote the child's success.

Five developmental areas (approaches to learning, health and physical well-being, language and communication development, social and emotional development and cognitive and general knowledge) along with a series of readiness indicators, provide an overview of the expectations of primary school for incoming students. The indicators provide teachers and parents a tool to better inform them about the specific strengths and needs of each individual child.

#### **Early Entrance/School Readiness Indicators**

#### Health and Physical Well-Being

- Eats a balanced diet
- Gets plenty of rest
- Receives regular medical and dental care
- Has had all necessary immunizations
- Uses pencils, crayons, scissors, and paint and does other activities that help develop both small muscles and large muscles

#### Language, Math and General Knowledge

- Uses 5-6 word sentences
- Sings simple songs
- Recognizes and says simple rhymes
- Can recite alphabet and can write most letters
- Can write name and is learning to write address
- Knows the difference between print and pictures
- Listens to stories read to them
- Asks questions
- Is leaning to count, understands one-to-one correspondence, and recognizes numbers
- Can identify and name basic colors and common shapes
- Beginning to sort and classify objects
- Is able to notice similarities and differences
- Understands simple concepts of time (night/day, today, yesterday, tomorrow)

#### **Social and Emotional Development**

- Follows simple rules and routines
- Is able to express his or her own needs and wants in an appropriate manner
- Accepts directions or limit-setting without temper tantrums
- Is curious and motivated to learn


- Explores and tries new things
- Plays/shares with other children
- Is able to be away from parent/family without being upset
- Is able to work well alone
- Has the ability to attend to tasks/listen for 10-15 minutes in a group setting
- Attends to and completes tasks without constant adult direction and assistance

### Self-Help

- Is able to perform self-care task such as using the bathroom, wiping nose, and washing hands independently
- Is able to dress self, including outdoor clothing
- Takes care of personal items and classroom materials
