Elective for 2023-24 School Year

AP Chemistry (11-12th grade)

This is an advanced Chemistry course that students will have an option at the end of the course to take an AP exam and earn college credit.

Art I (9th-12th Grade)

In this course, students will learn the fundamentals of art such as color, composition, and technique. We will practice with several different forms of medium throughout the year.

Art II (For students who have completed Art I previously)

This course teaches students advanced art techniques. Students will explore a variety of two-dimensional and three-dimensional media throughout the year to build artistic confidence and creativity. We will focus on the refinement of skills as well as the planning process.

Athletic Training (10-12th Grade)

This is a weight lifting and advanced physical education class.

Band (9-12th Grade)

This elective is offered to all high school students. They will master the playing of a musical instrument and participate in Marching and Pep Band.

Cinema & Literature (9-12th Grade)

In this course, students will watch movies to develop literature analysis skills. Assignments will be designed to help students recognize themes, plot progression, character analysis, point of view, etc.

Communications (9-12th Grade)

In this course, students will be exposed to different types of communication, such as verbal, non-verbal, and written. Furthermore, they will practice their verbal communication skills by presenting a few different speeches.

Dual Enrollment (10-12th Grade)

If students meet Dual Enrollment qualifications, they may take dual enrollment classes.

Forensics (11-12th Grade)

Forensic science is the science beyond crime scene investigations. Students will learn how to interpret scientific data, perform lab investigations and use deductive reasoning to solve crimes.

HS Computers (9-12th Grade)

Students will learn Google, Microsoft Office as well as netiquette skills. The students will also use the Testout program.

Human Biology (11-12th grade)

This will be an upper grade elective that students will focus on the study of the human body and how it operates.

Life Skills (9-12th Grade)

In this course, students will learn the skills needed to find a career, find and maintain a vehicle, make informed decisions about housing and maintenance, introduce personal finance, and personal care. Professionals from the community will be invited to speak to the class about the various topics presented.

Online Lab (10-12th Grade)

Students may take classes through Edgenuity or Michigan Virtual.

Psychology/Sociology (9-12th Grade)

This elective course aims to give students a basic understanding of human behavior and mental processes. History, research methodology, behavior, development, and personality are just a few of the topics that will be covered. Students will also be introduced to social psychology- how humans behave in groups.

SAT Prep (9-12th Grade)

This course is designed to work on strategies and skills to prepare students for the SAT.
