Honors courses offered are English 1-4, Math II, Math III, Pre-Calculus, Biology, Chemistry I, Earth/Environmental Science, Civics & Economics, American History, Economics and Personal Finance, Orchestra, Band, Art, and Career and Technical Education courses.

AP courses offered are Literature and Composition, Calculus AB, Calculus BC, and AP Computer Science may be taken at the Career Technical & Educational Center (CTEC). Students may also take additional honors and AP courses online through North Carolina Virtual Public School (NCVPS).

Dual Enrollment is offered through Collegiate Start at Elon University and students may complete Career and College Promise courses at Alamance Community College.

Class rank is determined by final grades earned in their four years of high school (9-12). Rank is determined by using a weighted quality point average, based on a 4.0 grading scale. An additional .5 quality point will be added to honors courses, including CTE community college courses designated as honors. An additional 1.0 quality point will be added to Advanced (AP) courses, International Baccalaureate (IB) courses, community college courses that are part of the Comprehensive Articulation Agreement or four-year college/university courses taken while in high school. *All courses are included in the GPA calculation unless a P is issued*.


