- Campers must refrain from sexual activity at camp

**Environmental Camp** - If you love being in God's Creation (or want to learn more about nature) this is the camp for you! There will be plenty of outdoor recreation and outdoor activities including hiking, birding, stargazing, nature journaling, and outdoor games. Campers will explore the unique natural habitats of the Black Hills and have a chance to learn basic ecological and environmental concepts, practice outdoor skills, develop problem-solving skills, and experience an array of environmental education opportunities. This camp will also have campfire sing-alongs, plenty of s'mores, arts and crafts, and opportunities to build community, strengthen relationships, and deepen faith.

**Art/Music Camp** - Calling all emerging artists, vocalists, mess-makers, and fun seekers! Spend a week creating art, perfecting your craft, and exploring multiple mediums in a judgment-free zone. Campers will learn many art-making processes - including creative clay, baking/cooking, fiber arts, watercolor, and more - and participate in beginner music camp (vocal performance, music theory, and writing music). Campers will have opportunities to perform/display their talents, discover new techniques - and develop techniques of their own - while learning from talented and renowned Lorri Ann Two Bulls (artist) and Jean Mornard+ (vocalist). This camp will also have campfire sing-alongs, plenty of s'mores, arts and crafts, and opportunities to build community, strengthen relationships, and deepen faith. NO EXPERIENCE NECESSARY - ALL SKILL LEVELS WELCOME!

**Confirmation Camp** - Confirmation Camp is a unique experience for seekers wishing to have deep, faith-filled conversations combined with the adventure and fun of a traditional summer camp experience (outdoor adventures, campfire conversations, and team-building activities). Campers will have a transformative confirmation experience exploring nature and growing in their relationship with God and each other. If you are looking for opportunities to build bonds of trust and friendship as you experience life in an intentional Christian community - this camp is for you. Campers will leave strengthened for service in their congregations, schools, and communities. This camp will also have campfire sing-alongs, plenty of s'mores, and arts and crafts. **Acolyte Camp** - Acolyte Camp is for anyone interested in actively living out their Baptismal Covenant through service - specifically serving during Anglican-Episcopal worship (lighting and extinguishing the altar candles, receiving the offering, assisting in Baptism and Eucharist, etc.). If you would like to enhance worship services and help glorify God by serving as a crucifer, server, torch bearer, Gospel bearer, and/or flag and banner bearer, this camp is for you. Campers will have thorough training in acolyte duties while experiencing the fun of summer camp. This camp will also have campfire sing-alongs, plenty of s'mores, arts and crafts, and opportunities to build community, strengthen relationships, and deepen faith.
