School Hours/ Attendance

- Campus opens at 7:30AM.
 - Breakfast is served from 7:30- 7:55AM daily
 - School day begins at 8:00AM
 - **K-6th Grade Homework Club every Tues- Friday from 7:30- 7:55 in library as needed**
 - Dismissal is at 2:45PM on Monday, Tuesday, Thursday, Friday
 - Dismissal is at 12:00PM on Wednesday
 - If your child will be absent please ensure you call the attendance line at (928) 341- 6477.
 - Please ensure your child arrives on time daily.
- This provides the greatest opportunity for students to build rapport with their class, be part of a learning community, and ensure they can give their personal best. You may review our attendance policy by going to tds@ssd11.org and clicking on Parent/ Student Handbook.



Uniforms

Students should ensure they come daily in appropriately fitting uniforms. Students are to wear red or white polo shirts with navy blue bottoms (pants, shorts, skirts). Shorts and skirts should be no shorter than the tips of students fingertips when hands are at their sides.

Closed toed shoes or sandals with a back strap may be worn. Jeans may be worn any day, only with TDS Spirit shirt. Jeans may not have any holes.

Students who do not comply with uniform policy will be sent to the nurse to contact parents for change of clothing. Please see our TDS Parent/ Student handbook for more information on uniform policy. This hand book can be found at tds@ssd11.org.

At times classrooms can become chilly and students are encouraged to have a light jacket/ sweater if needed.

Student Drop- Off / Pick-Up

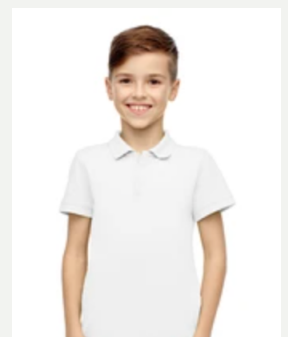
Any student arriving/ picked up by car must use the Looper lane in back of the school off Columbia Ave. The front parking lot is only for families with appointments or those **parents who park and walk their child to the cafeteria.** Students may not be in the parking lot at any time without an adult with them.

Please review road safety rules with your child if they will be walking or riding their bike. Students should go directly to/ from school. Should walk with a sibling or trusted friend. Remain on sidewalks and marked crosswalks. Be vigilant, keeping hands and feet to self at all times.

Caring for Our Neighborhoods

We want to ensure everyone is safe coming and going to school. It begin by treating our surrounding neighborhoods with respect and ensuring private property is respected.

If you choose to park in nearby neighborhoods to allow your child to walk, please ensure you are respectful of others property, do not block driveways, following all traffic signs. Remind children to stay off other's property, away from cars, and put any trash into trash cans.

School Supplies

We provide our families with a list of requested, but optional school supplies by grade level. These supplies are shared and used within the classroom during the school year. Individual teachers may request specific items for student use, but should be very limited in nature. If for any reason you need support with school supplies or backpack for your child please see our office. We will do our best to support if supplies are available.

While all school supplies are optional we do encourage that you ensure your child does have a **set of personal headphones/ earbuds** for their daily use in the classroom, and a **waterbottle** with their name/ classroom number clearly marked. We have refillable, refrigerated and filtered water for their use throughout the day.

Vistors/ Volunteers

We love our visitors and volunteers! However, there is a process that any visitor and volunteer must complete to be inside the school area.

Single Day Visitor- If you would like to visit our school/ child's classroom on a particular day, you may stop at the office and get a visitor request form. With our office support you will complete the form, filling out your reason for your visit, date, and time. Administration will review and contact you to make appropriate arrangements. Visitors must be accompanied by a staff member at all times.

School Volunteers: If you would like to volunteer, be part of our PTL, or attend field trips prior to coming to campus you must complete a clearing process by our school district. Please contact our office to begin the process! 928- 341- 6400. The volunteer clearing process is good for 1 school year and must be renewed annually.

Contacting Your Child's Teacher

During the first weeks of school establish with your child's teacher your preferred method of communication. When you have a question, concern please always reach out to your child's teacher first. All staff try to reply within 24 hrs of contact.

Teachers will typically respond in the morning 7:30- 7:50AM, during planning time (varies by grade level), or after school 2:45-ep about 4:00PM.

If after speaking with your child's teacher you still have questions/ concerns, please feel free to contact administration. We are happy to speak by phone or schedule an appointment to meet in person. You may contact our office by calling (928) 341-6400.

Horario Escolar/Asistencia

- El campus abre a las 7:30 a. m.

- La salida es a las 12:00PM los miércoles.
- Si su hijo/a va a faltar, por favor, asegúrese de llamar a la línea de asistencia al (928) 341-6477.

Por favor, asegúrese de que su hijo/a llegue puntual todos los días. Esto les brinda la mejor oportunidad para establecer una buena relación con su clase, formar parte de una comunidad de aprendizaje y asegurarse de dar lo mejor de sí mismos. Uniformes

Los estudiantes deben asegurarse de venir diariamente con uniformes que les queden bien. Los estudiantes deben usar camisas polo rojas o blancas con pantalones azul marino (pantalones, pantalones cortos, faldas).

Los pantalones cortos y las faldas no deben ser más cortos que las puntas de los dedos de los estudiantes cuando tienen las manos a los costados.

Se pueden usar zapatos cerrados o sandalias con tira trasera.

Entrada y Salida de Estudiantes

Todo estudiante que llegue o sea recogido en coche debe usar el carril Looper, ubicado detrás de la escuela, cerca de la avenida Columbia.

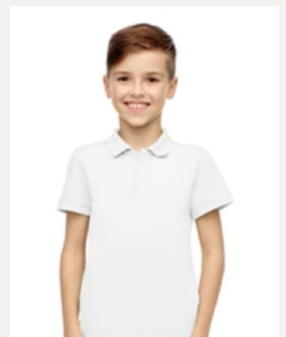

Suministros escolares

Proporcionamos a nuestras familias una lista de útiles escolares solicitados, pero opcionales, por nivel de grado. Los maestros individuales pueden solicitar artículos específicos para uso de los estudiantes, pero deben ser de naturaleza muy limitada. Disponemos de agua recargable, refrigerada y filtrada para su uso durante todo el día.

Voluntarios escolares: Si desea ser voluntario, formar parte de nuestro equipo de padres y maestros (PTL) o asistir a excursiones escolares antes de venir al campus, debe completar un proceso de autorización con nuestro distrito escolar. ¡Comuníquese con nuestra oficina para comenzar el proceso! 928-341-6400. El proceso de autorización para voluntarios es válido por un año escolar y debe renovarse anualmente.
