<u>Assessment</u>

There are 3 different types of assessments that we utilize in Laurens 55 to address a variety of needs.

State Accountability Assessments:

These are state required assessments utilized to measure and compare student achievement throughout the State of SC and beyond. (ex. SC Ready, EOC, etc.)

Universal Screeners:

Their primary purpose is to screen ALL students at some point in their PK-12 career to identify potential needs that may require additional services/interventions. Some of these are also state required. (ex. MAP, Satchel, etc.)

Instructional Assessments:

These are instructional or curriculum based assessments that provide immediate or quick feedback to both the teacher and student that can be used drive instruction, help in individual goal setting and more. (ex. HMH Growth, Mastery Connect, etc.)

What is MTSS?-Part 2

Laurens 55 is in the process of developing and implementing a consistent standardized MTSS process for ALL schools.

Last month, all Principals and Guidance Counselors received preliminary training and information on MTSS and this district process. Our next step will be for each school to begin holding MTSS meetings on individual students whom are still showing the need for additional support/intervention after several classroom interventions have been implemented, monitored and adjusted over a period of time.

We will be coming to you later this year for your feedback in order to monitor and tweak this process to ensure it is working effectively for our students and staff of Laurens 55.
