## PROJECT FINANCING INFO:

To raise our current budgeted debt service payment capacity (2.57 million) under Dr. Ruhlman's plan and as presented on numerous occasions we would potentially need \$511,311.75 annually to fill the gap and fund the project:

\$100,000- \$3.51/month \$42.12/year

\$200,000- \$7.02/month \$84.24/year

\$121,500 (median household)- \$4.26/month \$51.12/year

This example is 100% fully local tax funded, no grants, no state funding.

If we receive the Public School Facility Improvement \$5M Grant, the gap in debt service capacity to fund the project would only be an additional \$217,407.09 annually:

\$100,000- \$1.49/month \$17.88/year

\$200,000- \$2.98/month \$35.76/year

\$121,500 (median household)-\$1.81/month \$21.72/year

This example is 100% fully local tax funded reduced by \$5M in grant funds, no state funding.

Numbers are rounded to the nearest cent, based on a 94% tax collection rate, and should be assumed as approximate estimates.

Figures are based on the difference between current budget debt service capacity and estimated future debt service payments.

Amounts are subject to change based on total assessed value of all taxable properties within the district, actual final cost of the project, bond cost, and bond interest rate.
