#### **Criteria:**

- Graduating in May 2024
- Minimum 2.5 GPA
- Little to no discipline record
- Little to no other scholarship offers
- Must be pursuing further education (can be trade school, community college, or 4-year university)

- Letter of recommendation (not required, but encouraged)
