FINANCIAL AID

Financial aid is available to **ALL** families through FACTS Grant & Aid.

- » All families can apply for financial aid.
- » Financial aid disbursements will be applied to the family tuition portion AFTER scholarships.
- » Families may be eligible for both financial aid AND a scholarship. Families are encouraged to apply to both. Both awards may be applied to a student's FACTs account.

FINANCIAL POLICIES

All tuition and incidental payments are paid in FACTS with auto pay setup only.

No payments will be accepted in the finance office. Late fees will apply if auto pay is turned off and payment is received after the due dates. Please note dates for auto pay set above.

Delinquent Account policy

Tuition & incidental payments must be paid in full for the student to remain in class and attend after school activities on the 1st of each month. There will be a \$30 late fee assessed for accounts past due. Any student who withdraws from FCA will be charged for that month's full tuition.

Split family responsibility percentages must be set up with finance prior to the first day of school

If not identified, finance will set 50% to both families for all tuition and incidental charges.
