- A Spring Pass includes Girls Soccer ,Baseball, Softball and Track. The cost of this pass is \$25.00.
- An All-Season Pass covers all of the above mentioned sports and costs \$225.00 per family. A student only pass costs \$95.00.

"Family" refers to father, mother, and siblings. Each family member will be issued a numbered pass. Each pass is non-transferable and is valid only for the person listed on it.

Passes are available from the Athletic Department at Grosse Ile High School between the hours of 9:00 a.m.-5:00 p.m.

"Student Only" presale tickets for away games may be available the day before and the day of the game in the main Office from 9:00 a.m.- 5:00 p.m.

What to do if school is delayed or cancelled.

At any time during the school year, it may be necessary to cancel school or delay the starting time. Schools could close or be delayed for a variety of reasons; extremely bad weather, poor road conditions, mechanical failures, or other emergency situations. While this is rare, you and your child must be prepared.

- If a storm moves in during the day, athletic practice cancellations are determined before dismissal. It would be extremely rare to send students home early. The normal practice is to complete the school day, but your child must know what to do and where to go in case he/she is sent home early. We never want to send children home not knowing whether or not they will be able to get inside.
