Your Water Usage, Online!

The city is currently in the process of upgrading our infrastructure by replacing our water meters with new Smart meters. These new meters transmit readings daily and provide a more detailed picture of water usage and possible leak issues. In addition to being able to pinpoint when a leak started, these new meters can show how much water is used in household use and irrigation. When we swap the meter out, it will impact read dates, so please be aware you may experience a bill with a shorter read time around 10 days followed by a bill with a longer read time around 50-60 days. This is due to the meter swap in the middle of the read cycle, and will impact your bill making your usual bill amount appear lower and higher in relation to the read time. The read time will normalize on the next bill cycle after the longer read time. To access your meter account after we have swapped your meter out, please contact us and we will provide you with your account information and the link to set up access. Oklahoma Highland Gathering

The 2023 Oklahoma Highland Gathering is an annual Scottish festival that will be held from Friday, October 20, 2023, 5:00 PM to Sunday, October 22, 2023, 6:00 PM at Choctaw Creek Park in Choctaw, Oklahoma. The festival is organized by the United Scottish Clans of Oklahoma and features a variety of activities such as IHGFsanctioned highland games, pipes and drums, folk and modern Celtic bands, highland dancing, Gaelic lessons, Viking reenactments, clan tents and ancestry resources, food trucks, local breweries, whisky tastings, vendors, blacksmithing, lace tatting, highland cattle (hielan coos) and more. The festival will kick off on Friday night with a fire ceremony (also known as the "calling of the clans") followed by a traditional ceilidh, a celebration with folk music, singing, dancing, and storytelling.

Bulk Waste Pickup Limitations and Fees

Reminder that sanitation service for account holders in Choctaw City limits includes a once a month bulk pickup. Waste Connections will pick up to 3 cubic yards worth of bulk waste, waste materials must be contained or tied into 4 ft bundles. Loose or unbundled waste will incur an additional fee of \$30.00 per load and waste in excess of 3 cubic yards will incur an additional fee of \$15.00 per cubic yard up to 9 cubic yards in total, and these fees will be posted on the next
