Recycling Pickup Schedule

Waste Connections picks up recycling every other week. Recycling pick-up will occur in the weeks December 4th and December 18th.

Bulk Trash Pickup Schedule

Bulk trash is picked up monthly based on your regular trash day. Find your trash day to see when your monthly Curbside Bulk Pick-Up will occur: **Monday**=1st Thursday of the month Tuesday = 2nd Thursday

Wednesday = 3rd Thursday

Thursday/Friday = 4th Thursday

During the week of Christmas, trash and recycle will not be picked up on Monday, December 25th and will be bumped one day for the remainder of the week; Monday's route will be picked up on Tuesday and Tuesday's route will be picked up on Wednesday and so on. The same will occur for New Year's Day, Monday, January 1st. Bulk pickup will not be affected during either holiday.

Sanitation Department

City of Choctaw Sanitation rates will be increasing effective on the December billing statements. Sanitation rates have increased to \$21.59 for regular sanitation service, \$17.38 for Senior rate sanitation service, and \$6.53 per additional poly cart.
