Bulk Trash Pickup Schedule



- You may receive multiple text alert notifications a month. Notifications may include Upcoming Events, Event Updates and Changes, and Event Details.
- You can text STOP at any time to remove yourself from the notification list

Alarm Permits

Residents and Business Owners! Alarm permits are required in the City of Choctaw. This permit ensures an enhanced sense of security and that law enforcement resources are optimized. In the event of an alarm activation, law enforcement can quickly and efficiently reach the homeowner to verify if it's a false alarm or a genuine emergency. This streamlined communication helps prevent unnecessary panic and disruption, while also enabling law enforcement to respond promptly to actual threats. It's \$25.00 to register your alarm and no fee for those 62 years and older. Alarm permits are not transferable for changes in ownership or leases. You can apply for a permit online or mail in an application with payment. Contact the permit technician for more questions or concerns at 405-390-2999.
