March 11th and 25th.


Bulk Trash Pickup Schedule

Metropolitan Fair Housing Council

In Oklahoma, individuals experiencing housing-related rights violations can seek assistance from the Metropolitan Fair Housing Council of Oklahoma, Inc (MFHC), supported by both federal and local funding. Whether you're a tenant or a housing provider, understanding and complying with federal and state laws is crucial to ensure fair and equal housing opportunities. Familiarizing yourself with the relevant laws can empower you to address any issues related to fair housing and landlord-tenant relations effectively.

If counselling and mediation efforts are unsuccessful, or if legal action is deemed necessary, MFHC may refer the complaint for legal representation at no cost to the complainant.

Speed Limit Reduced On Harper!

You may notice the speed limit has been lowered on Harper from 40 mph -30 mph from NE 10th street to NE 23rd. This will be the speed limit until the road can be widened and repaired.

The concern has been for our students going to and from school especially on their lunch hour as well as families enjoying the park.

I have instructed our officers to extend grace for a period of time as everyone gets use to the new speed limit.

We will be evaluating more streets for consistency of speed limits as well as speed limits as it relates to safety.
