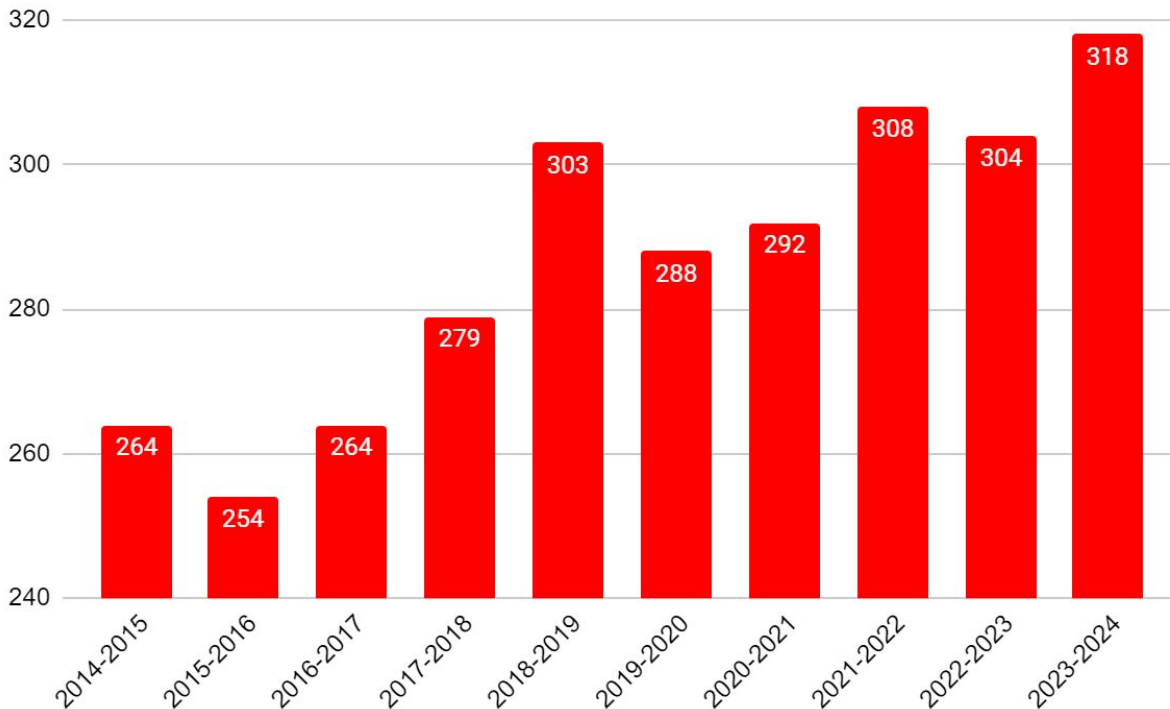
Pleasanton Public Schools is a state accredited Nebraska school district. The high school is a class "D1" school and participates in the activities of the Nebraska School Activities Association. All PK-12 students are in one building in Pleasanton, NE. The 7-12 wing of the building was opened in 1993 and the elementary wing opened in 2016. Pleasanton Public also provides early childhood special education services across the district to qualifying students. The mission of Pleasanton Public Schools is *"Through cooperation of students, staff, family and community our mission is to offer everyone educational opportunities to excel and become responsible citizens in an ever-changing world."*

The school district covers roughly 153 square miles and had a total enrollment of 318 students on October 1, 2023, which includes 18 students enrolled in Pre K. The district is experiencing enrollment growth, growing 3% - 5% each year.
