SCHOOL AND COMMUNITY PROFILE

Glen Allen High School is Henrico County Public Schools' newest high school. The school in northwestern Henrico County opened in 2010 and comprises approximately 1,900 students and 150 staff members. Students at Glen Allen also enjoy opportunities available at HCPS' three Advanced Career Education Centers. The school is home to the Center for Education and Human Development, one of HCPS' 16 high school specialty centers.

ACADEMIC CHARACTERISTICS

The school year is divided into two semesters of 18 weeks, with nine-week reporting periods. The curriculum offers a variety of college-prep, Advanced Placement and honors courses as well as a variety of electives in business, marketing, family and consumer sciences, technology education, fine arts and the general academic areas.

Center for Education and Human Development

The Center for Education and Human Development, located at Glen Allen, is a rigorous four-year program designed for students aspiring to be educators or pursue other leadership opportunities.

GPA and CLASS RANKING

Class rank and grade point average are determined by the levels of courses taken and the grades earned in those courses. Beginning with the sixth grade class of 2021-22 (graduating cohort of 2027-28) and beyond, grades in high school credit-bearing courses taken in middle school will be computed into the high school grade point average. Students are ranked numerically in ascending order, according to GPA, at the end of the junior year and at the end of the first semester of the senior year. Students who are earning either a Standard or an Advanced Studies diploma are included in class rank. Beginning with the class of 2017, total grade points include an additional 0.5 quality point for any honors and a 1.0 quality point for any AP/DE class taken. Parents/Guardians may elect to have class rank excluded from appearing on the student transcript (opt out).
