SCHOOL AND COMMUNITY PROFILE

Mills E. Godwin High School is located in the suburban far West End of Henrico County. The school was built in 1980 and has a faculty and staff of more than 150 and a student population of approximately 1,800. Godwin houses the county's Todd Allen Phillips Center for Medical Sciences. In addition, students have opportunities available to them at HCPS' three Advanced Career Education Centers.

ACADEMIC CHARACTERISTICS

The school year is divided into two semesters of 18 weeks, with nine-week reporting periods. The curriculum offers a variety of college-prep, Advanced Placement and honors courses as well as a variety of electives in business, marketing, family and consumer sciences, technology education, fine arts and the general academic areas.

Center for Medical Sciences

The Todd Allen Phillips Center for Medical Sciences enrolls qualified students with a genuine interest in medicine and health sciences. With assistance from its partnership with VCU School of Medicine, the center provides opportunities for students to gain early exposure to advanced coursework, research laboratories and medical shadowing.

GPA and CLASS RANKING

Class rank and grade point average are determined by the levels of courses taken and the grades earned in those courses. Beginning with the sixth grade class of 2021-22 (graduating cohort of 2027-28) and beyond, grades in high school credit-bearing courses taken in middle school will be computed into the high school grade point average. Students are ranked numerically in ascending order, according to GPA, at the end of the junior year and at the end of the first semester of the senior year. Students who are earning either a Standard or an Advanced Studies diploma are included in class rank. Beginning with the class of 2017, total grade points include an additional 0.5 quality point for any honors and a 1.0 quality point for any AP/DE class taken. Parents/Guardians may elect to have class rank excluded from appearing on the student transcript (opt out).
