With the approval of this document, the Henrico County School Board waives nonresident student per capita tuition (\$6,200) for the children of nonresident HCPS employees who enroll in Henrico County Public Schools pursuant to an approved variance for the 2025-2026 school year. Pursuant to HCPS Policy P6-03-004 and Section 22.1-5 of the Code of Virginia, the families of nonresident students attending HCPS schools on an approved variance will be charged the actual cost of special education services and gifted and talented services (not listed above).
