### Our Community

Montville Township is a suburban community of 22,450 in Morris County, New Jersey, located 34 miles from New York City. In 2024, the ranking and review website Niche.com named Montville #9 for "Best Places to Live in Morris County" and #71 out of 642 "Best Places to live in New Jersey."

### Our District

In 2024, Montville Township Public Schools, a Pre-K to 12 district, was recognized by:

### Our School

Montville Township High School is a comprehensive, four-year public school with a current enrollment of 280 seniors out of 1032 students. Montville Township High School values its 10:1 student-teacher ratio. The majority of the faculty have earned at least one advanced degree. Montville Township High School offers over 52 extracurricular activities and 27 varsity athletic teams. The majority of our students are actively engaged in our school and broader community.

### Curriculum Highlights

Montville Township High School offers over 175 courses that include:

- 24 Advanced Placement courses in both core academic subjects and the arts, and a rigorous Honors program offering 34 courses
- 10 Early College courses providing students with the opportunity to participate in dual enrollment and earn college credit
- An Independent Study/Research Program

Nationally recognized by *District Administration*, the Humanities Research Program engages students in the process of combining student conducted research with end-product creation and leadership development.

- **DECA:** students qualified and competed in the International Career Development Conference in a variety of events
- **American Legion Auxiliary Girls State:** 1 student selected and attended


