Kindergarten Screening/Registration and Birth to 3 Screening on March 21 and 22

We are busy getting ready to host this year's Kindergarten Screening/Registration and Birth to 3 Screening at the Miller United Methodist Church on March 21 and 22. If you have a child who will turn 5 before September 1, 2024 please sign him/her up by calling Laela at 605-853-2711 or mailing the form found in the Miller Press to Miller Elementary, 623 East 4th St, Miller, SD 57362. A child born before this date may attend Kinderstart or Kindergarten in the fall. Speech and Language, Hearing, General Concepts, and Fine Motor Skills will be evaluated. The screening provides valuable information for parents and school personnel.

We also conduct screenings for children from Birth to age 3 if parents are concerned about their child's development in any of the above areas. Registration forms are available in the Miller Press, or you can call Laela to sign your child up. Students and Anxiety

Academic anxiety is the stress, worry, and fear that some students feel around their schoolwork, grades, and assignments. An especially stressful time may be when students transition from second to third grade as they begin earning traditional letter grades for the first time. Doing their best every day without putting pressure on themselves is something I visit with students about. None of us have perfect days, and I let them know that I make mistakes every day! There are so many pressures in society, so providing a setting full of adults who support them is our goal. Talking with children about their concerns is so helpful to them, and we are here to help if you would like assistance. We have a social worker on staff and work with Community Counseling to assist students with coping skills. My door is always open to students who need to visit, as well. I enjoy the conversations I get to have with our students!
