	College Ready Seal	Earn remediation free scores on the ACT or SAT. Current remediation free scores: 22 Math, 22 Reading, 18 English		
	Military Enlistment	Provide evidence of enlistment in a branch of the United States Armed Forces		
	Citizenship Seal Govt Score ____ US Hist Score ____	Proficient scores of 700 or higher in US History and American Government end of course exam to earn a “B” or higher in an approved CCP history course		
	Science Seal Bio Score ____	Proficient score of 700 or higher on Biology end of course exam, or earn a “B” or higher in an approved CCP science course		
	Honors Diploma __Academic __Art __Career Tech __International Baccalaureate __Social Science & Civil Engagement __STEM Honors	Meet criteria for 1 of 6 honors diplomas. See counselor for requirement		
	Seal of Biliteracy	Student demonstrates proficiency in English and one other world language through a series of test-based options		
	Technology	Earn a “B” or higher in an appropriate CCP technology course or complete a technology course that meets criteria established by the Ohio Department of Education		
	Industry-Recognized Credential Seal	Earn an industry-recognized credential that is aligned with a job that is determined to be “in-demand” in this area		

Interest In	Local Seals		Completed	Counselor Verified
	Community Service	80 hours of community service. A student pursuing this seal must have a plan pre-approved by the school counselor. Students pursuing this seal will track their own hours and obtain their own signatures. Completed service hours form is due May 1 of the student's senior year.		
	Student Engagement	Active participation in at least 1 Waterford High School extracurricular each year of high school, of which a student does NOT earn high school credit. Students pursuing this seal must obtain signatures from the activity's advisor, coach, etc., as verification of active participation.		
	Fine & Performing Arts	4 high school credits in the fine and/or performing arts. Fine arts credits earned through CCP or transferred in from another high school also qualify.
