ANNUAL TRUANCY NOTIFICATION 2025-2026

Required by Texas Education Code, Section 25.095

Dear Parent/Guardians:

The purpose of this written notification is to provide an overview of the Texas Compulsory Attendance law and La Vernia Independent School District's Truancy Prevention Measures.

A student must be in attendance each school day for the entire time instruction is provided. A student is in violation of the state's compulsory attendance law when he/she has three or more unexcused days or parts of days in a four-week period. The student is subject to truancy prevention measures under **Texas Education Code 25.0915**. Accumulation of ten unexcused days or parts of days in a six-month period, the parent whose student is in violation of these laws is subject to prosecution under **Texas Education Code 25.093**, and/or the student is subject to a referral to truancy court under **Section 65.003 Family Code**.

La Vernia ISD recognizes that quality education is the result of the home and school working together. Therefore, to mitigate the need to file a complaint, the district will follow Truancy Prevention Measures allowable by Texas Education Code, Section 25.0915.

1. Utilize the Ascendar System to notify parents/guardians daily of absences recorded for students.
2. Send a Warning Notice notifying the parent/guardian that their child has accumulated three (3) or more unexcused absences in a four (4) week period.
3. When a student reaches (3) unexcused absences, they may be referred to an Attendance Improvement Committee.
4. A parent conference will be requested with the parent/guardian, child, and campus administrator. A parent's failure to attend this conference will not prevent the district from filing a complaint should further absences occur.
5. A second attempt to make parent contact if the parent fails to attend the scheduled conference (phone or face-to face)
6. A complaint will be filed with the appropriate court.
