#### **Superintendent Notes Dear Parents and Guardians,**

Last week our school hosted our annual Homecoming Week. From all indications it was a very enjoyable week for all students, parents, and teachers. In reality, school personnel are very nervous during a typical Homecoming Week with the extra activities, the pep rally, and the Homecoming Dance. I believe it says a lot about our students and parents that everything went as planned and there were no issues. It was amazing to see the students and staff dress up for all of the various theme days. We do have a great group of students here at Lo-Ma, and a great group of parents raising their children the right way.

#### **Building Project**
