A Message from Mrs. Kiger K-6 Elementary Principal

Logan Magnolia Elementary is thriving this fall thanks to the efforts of our community, staff and students. As the year 2023 comes to an end, let's take a moment to reflect on the greatness of the first four months of the year.

- Preschool enrollment is strong with over 50 students in 4 year old preschool.
- During the fall assessment period, 89% of elementary students were proficient on FAST math
- Implementation of the new literacy program is challenging students and increasing exposure to science and social studies content
- Our first FUN Run and outdoor family night was a success
- Our preschool, kindergarten, and first grade staff are participating in Early Childhood LETRS training to continue to develop their knowledge about literacy acquisition for our youngest learners
- Over 60 students in grades 4-6 are enrolled in the elementary musical
- Kindness has been observed in many settings

What can you expect in 2024?

- Art volunteers continue to provide extended learning opportunities-let us know if you want to help
- Math and literacy instruction will be monitored for effectiveness and we'll begin to look at what systemic changes might need to be made to more accurately reflect that work (report cards)
- We'll analyze our science and social studies standards to determine gaps in experiences
- New experiences will be explored as learning opportunities for our students
- Spring Family night will bring everyone together for fun and learning


