





It's been an exciting couple months of academic, college, and career planning for our students!
On February 9, the entire junior class traveled to the Harrison County Career Expo in Woodbine, where about 25 different local businesses were represented. Juniors were able to explore potential career paths, network with professionals, and foster early career awareness and informed decision-making for their futures.
On February 22, juniors also had the option to take the Armed Services Vocational Aptitude Battery (ASVAB) Test. About 50% of the junior class opted to take the test. Afte the test, students' scores were interpreted, helping students identify their current and potential abilities and skills, as well as possible career options.
□ We hosted the Logan-Magnolia ACAC College Fair on February 26: over 40 different colleges and military branches were in attendance and students from neighboring districts (Treynor, Woodbine) were also able to attend. 80% of students scanned with at least one college, and the top five colleges scanned by students were Iowa State, UNO, Iowa, UNL, and Graceland.
On February 27 we inducted 12 new members into the National Honor Society, recognizing the service, leadership, and character of these students.
☐ And the following month, on March 20, the entire sophomore class traveled to Iowa Western Community College for their Career Forum. 16 different industries were represented. Students could attend three different Q&A sessions in their top career interest areas all while getting the chance to explore a college campus.
We are well underway in the craziness of spring activities, but the end of the school year will be here before we know it! 


