Firestone Park

In 1933, Harvey S. Firestone deeded land on East Park Avenue in the city of Columbiana to be converted into a community recreational park containing tennis courts, baseball diamonds, a football field, a swimming pool and other park facilities. Dedication of the original facilities was made in 1937, and subsequent upgrades and additions have been made in accordance with the intent of the original plan. The high school football stadium, weight training facility, and baseball/softball fields are located in Firestone Park. Columbiana Schools are one of two districts in the state of Ohio to host athletic programs in their community park. The cooperative partnership between the city of Columbiana and Columbiana Schools preserves this long-standing tradition. The schools maintain close involvement in many areas of the community, with the local park facilities and public library playing significant roles in the daily life of the school and family.
