












Congratulations, 2025 Graduates

The displays will be located in the entrances to the Jr./Sr. High School near the front fover and the gym entrance. These are large, horizontal touchscreen TVs that will give visitors access everything they need to know about our school district.

From these touchscreens, you will find news, events, menus and recent photos. What's more: these screens will include digital access to previous Clyde-Savannah yearbooks, alumni who served in the military, and athletic statistics, including a digital Hall of Fame.

"I am excited about our new Digital Touch Hall of Fame for Athletics and the community," said Athletic Director Pamela Lockwood. "This long-awaited addition is more than

just a display, it's a celebration of our rich athletic tradition and the people who have helped shape it. It allows us to honor past and present athletes, coaches and community members in a modern, dynamic way that brings their stories to life for generations to come."



The digital content will also be available via QR code, so visitors can access everything right on their phones. Capital Project Update Improvements Are on the Way


