Teacher Compact - The Kindergarten teachers and staff of Byron elementary School will provide quality curriculum and instruction in a supportive and effective learning environment. - Provide at least 15 minutes of in class reading time per day.
- Return all Remind, phone and email messages within 24 business hours.
- Encourage parents/ guardians to read at least

10-15 minutes with children nightly.

- Provide frequent reports to parents regarding their child's progress.
- Be available to meet with parents/guardians during planning period after ap-

pointment has been scheduled.

- Promote at home reading to parents.
- Provide sight word list for at home practice.
