West Morris Mendham High School, one of two high schools in the West Morris Regional High School District, was among the first public high schools in New Jersey to offer the *International Baccalaureate Diploma Programme*. Additionally, West Morris Regional is the only district in New Jersey offering the *International Baccalaureate Career Programme*.

Consistently ranked as one of the top high schools in New Jersey and the nation across a variety of media outlets, Mendham High School has earned recognition on *The College Board's AP Honor Roll*, and has been designated as having a *Model World Language Program* by the New Jersey Department of Education.

SCHOOL/COMMUNITY

Serving grades 9–12, we are a college preparatory institution for residents of Mendham and Chester, semi-rural communities with a mix of upper-middle class to high-income families. The program of studies features a wide range of International Baccalaureate and Advanced Placement offerings. Current enrollment for the 2025-2026 school year is 983 students.

CURRICULUM

West Morris Mendham offers a four-year comprehensive program that includes a wide range of elective courses. Within our academic offerings we strive to cultivate and assess the development of those attributes articulated in the IB Learner Profile. These traits include being knowledgeable, principled, open-minded, caring, balanced and reflective while actively thinking, inquiring, communicating and taking risks. Critically evaluating information and its sources and utilizing relevant data to solve problems and articulate those solutions in writing and oral argument is a recurring exercise in our coursework.

DUAL ENROLLMENT COURSES

West Morris Mendham High School partners with Seton Hall University and Fairleigh Dickinson University to provide Dual Enrollment opportunities for the following courses: Art 1 IB, Art 2 IB, Biology AP and IB-HL, Sports, Exercise & Health Science IB, Business and Management, Chemistry AP, Theatre 1, Economics IB/AV, Environmental Science AP, European History AP, US Government and Politics AP, Physics C AP, Physics 2 IB, Physics 1 IB/AP, Psychology IB, Research Methods in Psychology IB-HL.

INTERNATIONAL BACCALAUREATE (IB)

This internationally-monitored curriculum challenges our most ambitious learners. The IB Diploma, widely accepted as the finest secondary program available, is awarded upon completion of a rigorous scholarly regimen comprising the Theory of Knowledge Course and an extended essay investigation, demonstrated mastery on internationally evaluated written and oral examinations, and the execution of a creativity-action-service project.

The IB Career-Related Programme is a two year framework incorporating IB principles across a curriculum tailored to career related study. The program includes two IB classes, career pathway coursework, and the following components of the IB core: the Personal & Professional Skills class, a service learning experience, a Language Development Portfolio, and a Senior Reflective Research Project.

GRADUATION REQUIREMENTS

To earn a West Morris Regional High School District diploma, a student shall be required to:

- Satisfactorily complete 120 credits of course work
- Satisfactorily meet departmental/discipline requirements: English (20 credits), Social Studies (15 credits), Mathematics (15 credits), Science (15 credits), Physical Education/Health (All years), World Language (10 credits) Visual & Performing Arts (5 credits), Career/Consumer/Family/Life Skills (5 credits), Financial/Economic Literacy (2.5 credits)
- Achieve baseline proficiency in any NJ state approved standardized test (ACT, NJGPA, PSAT)
