POSITION TITLE: Classroom Teacher/Intervention Specialist

GRADE LEVEL: 7-12th grade

PRIMARY RESPONSIBILITIES:

- To plan daily instruction and learning activities that incorporate IEP goals, Ohio Learning Standards and extended standards.
- Develop and implement individualized IEP goals, assess students, collect data, and report progress.
- Write ETR and IEP reports and participate in ETR and IEP meetings.
- Collaborate between teachers, service personnel (Speech, OT, PT) and outside agencies including school districts to help the student meet their goals.
- Communicate student progress with parents.
- Administer state assessments and other required school testing.
- Manage classroom discipline in accordance with the PAWS system.
- Create a positive learning environment.

QUALIFICATIONS:

- A minimum of a bachelor's degree in Deaf Education or Special Education
- A licensed Intervention Specialist - Resident Educators accepted
- Able to communicate effectively in American Sign Language
- Has experience working with students who have behavioral needs
- Able to work effectively as part of a collaborative educational team
